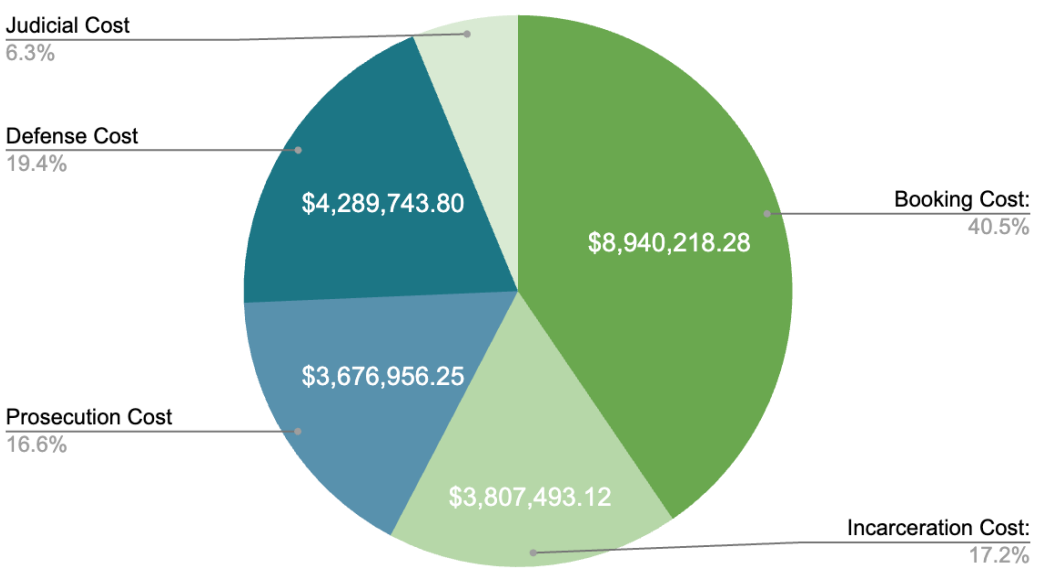


Cost of Misdemeanor System



Oklahoma Appleseed research indicates that the misdemeanor system currently costs the state roughly \$22.7 million dollars a year to operate. Misdemeanor system reforms could help alleviate costs involved with every component of the system above and save Oklahoma and its tax-payers significant amounts of expenditures.
