

ACTIVITIES REPORT
ON STRENGTHENING OF CBOs AT VILLAGE LEVEL
HELD BETWEEN THE 1ST-8TH AUGUST, 2022

The journey started from Tamenglong on the morning of 1st August 2022 with 4 staffs along with a volunteer and a driver and reached Makuai village in the evening. The church and the CBO members extended their courtesy to the visiting team. The visiting team covered 7 (seven) different project villages and successfully conducted three awareness programs to empower and strengthen village level CBOs. The activities were organized under the following banner:

1. *Review on roles and responsibilities of the formed CBOs and community leaders*
2. *One day awareness program on E-shram and NFSA*
3. *Formation of SHGs*



The programs covered the objective of roles and responsibilities of CBOs in order to strengthen and capacitate them to sort out families and household to achieve their deserving rights and entitlement under concern governmental departments. We have highlighted the plight of NFSA and MGNREGA in Tousem area and Tamenglong at large. Forms for new registration and additional registration in NFSA have been given out to every village. The basic and detail information on E-shram Card and its benefits have been presented to the participants at every village. Since most of the people are working under unorganized sector and majority of the participants did not have the card. We look forward to bring CSC credential person to do the enrollment on the project villages. Under the SHG formation the participants were told about how and why SHG is formed, they were trained in book keeping, loaning and enlighten them about the visions, scopes and purpose of forming SHG. The SHG objective have been shared that apart from achieving sustainable livelihood it is also a tool for women empowerment to strengthen their self-esteem and voice out to help certain social issues viz. education, health, sanitation at the micro level.

Throughout the program the host villages have extended their hospitality and co-operation and people had participated the program with enthusiasm. Apart from planned activities the team had an opportunity to interact with the local church elders, village elders, women group, village authorities and youth groups.

Meanwhile, we face certain challenges in implementing the programs. Due to the incessant rain, the remoteness and the rough terrain it is very difficult for the visiting team to access the place on time. To our observation it is learned that in some villages the target groups were very less due to job migration to the nearest town (Tamenglong) in order to sustain their livelihood. The ground reality is that in some village the village authority are not well informed of the government schemes and beneficiaries, and they are sometimes unable to help and guide the

public and to some it is due to ignorance that people are unaware about their rights. It is learn that most potential and literate persons who can help the local did not stay at the village, they have shifted to towns and cities. However, we have reassured our commitment in every village to render our help and support at our capacity to achieve their rights and entitlement. Further, we have also assured to monitor the program at our best possible means. On the last day i.e, 8th of August evening, we move out from Old Phelong village and returned to Tamenglong.
