Executive proposition

AI-ready discovery begins with business reality, not with the technology chosen to exploit it.

Discovery before architecture

Many programmes begin with target technology, solution design or data migration before the organisation has established a reliable understanding of the work itself.

AI readiness should begin earlier. The first task is to discover the enterprise as it actually operates.

Evidence, not assumption

Enterprise discovery captures observable business evidence: capabilities, actors, events, processes, information, decisions, applications, interfaces, policies, controls and dependencies.

The objective is not to produce another document set. It is to create reusable knowledge assets whose provenance and status can be traced.

Behaviour reveals meaning

Business events are especially valuable because they expose what actually happens: who acts, what changes, what information is used and what consequences follow.

Behavioural discovery helps separate enduring business meaning from the implementation details of individual systems.

From discovery to semantics

Discovered evidence is progressively structured into canonical concepts and relationships. Different domain vocabularies can then be reconciled without erasing legitimate local meaning.

This creates the basis for ontology, semantic validation and ultimately a knowledge graph.

Governance from the beginning

Discovery must preserve provenance, authority, applicability and temporal state. These are not metadata decorations added at the end; they determine whether the resulting knowledge can be trusted.

Security and compliance constraints should likewise be captured as part of enterprise understanding rather than treated as external controls.

AI readiness as an outcome

AI becomes more useful when it consumes governed enterprise knowledge rather than isolated documents and disconnected datasets.

The goal of discovery is therefore not simply better documentation. It is a trusted semantic foundation that allows AI to retrieve and reason within enterprise context.
