

## CANADA DAY PARADE

### INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANADA DAY PARADE PARTICIPANTS

1. The person in charge of the entry **MUST** sign the Application Form & Waiver.
2. Mail, email, fax or drop the signed form to the Whitehorse Legion or gave it to the parade controller at the start.
3. The parade will start at 11 AM **SHARP** please be there on time.
4. The parade forms up on Main St, between 4<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Ave and along part of 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. Floats and vehicles **ARE REQUIRED** to approach from 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.
5. The Parade Route follows Main St, then LEFT on 2nd Ave, RIGHT on Ogilvie St.
6. Please follow the directions of the parade guide volunteers. Those on foot are invited to march towards Shipyards Park; floats and vehicles will turn RIGHT onto Front St. and use the alley beside Lumel studio to make their way to Black Street to unload passengers from floats and vehicles. **Have a plan as to where you will go after the parade, do not stop the parade.**
7. BE SAFETY CONCIIOUS AT ALL TIME. Keep the speed at a walking level and keep up with the parade. Bicycle, motorcycle, and ATV riders MUST wear a proper helmet.
8. **DO NOT THROW GOODIES TO THE KIDS!** The danger is that kids will run into the traffic to get the goodies and could get run over, **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE**, so please hand the goodies out.
9. Walking entries must walk fast enough so as not to cause a disruption or a large gap in the parade flow. **Be considerate to other participants!**
10. Animal entries must have a way to clean up IMMEDIATELY when animals defecate.
11. VIPs will receive additional instructions.
