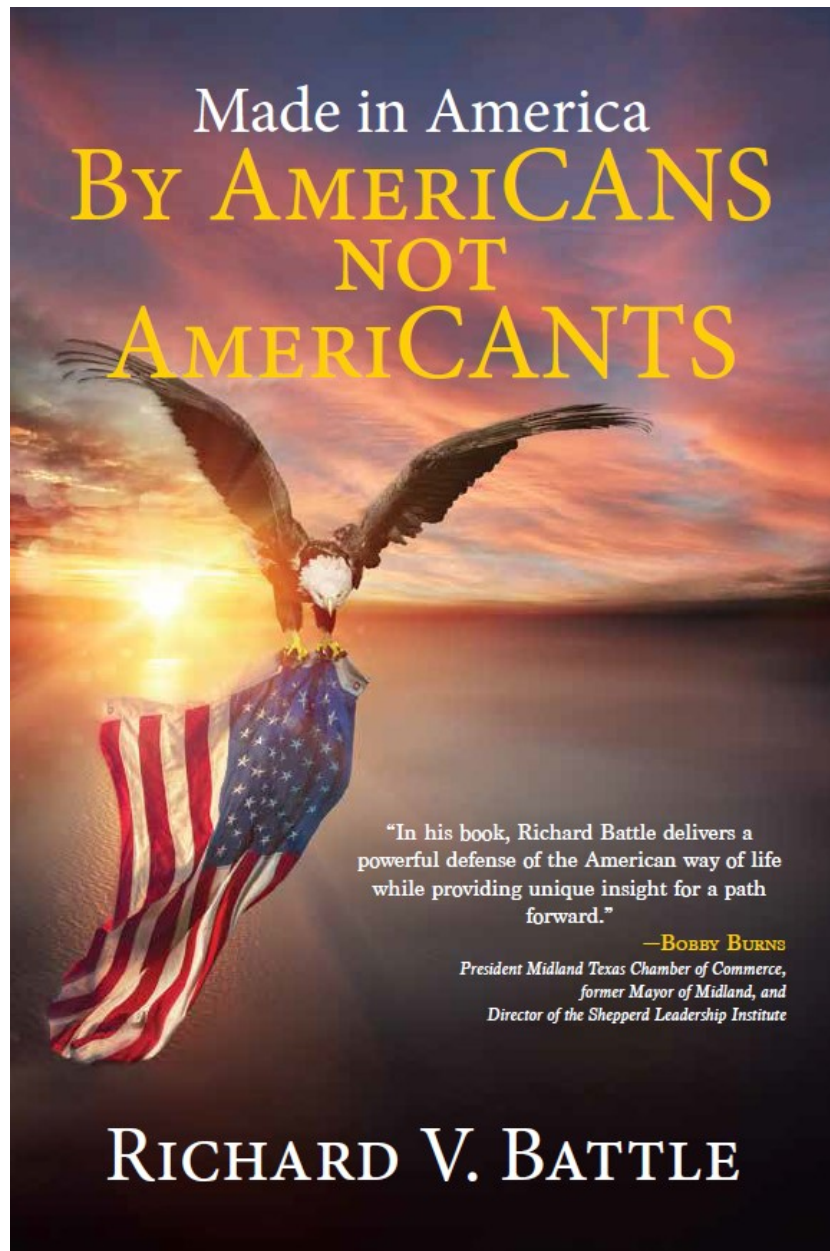

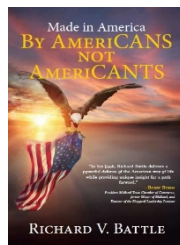

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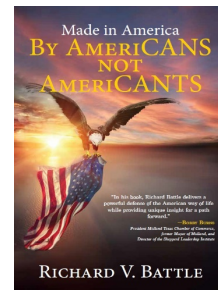

Reagan's positive attitude needed today more than ever

How the former president's optimism inspired a nation

As we celebrate President Ronald Reagan's birthday on Feb. 6, I reflect on his impact from my personal experiences and his example of leadership for all of us.

He was elected president at an age when most people showed down and enjoyed retirement. Reagan demonstrated that it is never too late to positively impact others. On March 30, 1981, I was in Caracas, Venezuela, on a company rewards trip. When we returned to the cruise ship that afternoon, I vividly remember listening to the

loved by the people because of his positive attitude and approach toward life. He related to every man, and almost every man related to him. His real heroes were common folk who performed uncommon feats of self-denial and courage.

As president, Reagan had a vision of where he wanted to lead the country, the principles to stay focused on the course to achieve objectives, and the positive outlook to persevere in the face of opposition and reversal. He brought dignity to the presidency and the country after a tumultuous period.

One of his greatest achievements was instituting policies that eventually ended the Cold War. Reagan pushed bold initiatives with conviction while some doubted his competence.

His willingness to move away from negotiating with the Soviets at their summit in Reykjavik, Iceland, in 1986 demonstrated his style of negotiating with confidence and strength rather than fear. This paradigm shift, combined with other policies, culminated with the Berlin Wall falling and the collapse of the Soviet Union in 1991. The Cold War was won without a shot, and Reagan's positive attitude was a significant contribution to the victory.

His optimism inspired people to be more than they were, and he demonstrated the possibility to achieve one's dreams, resulting pride in America and being American in a period of peace and prosperity. President Reagan's positive attitude and leadership were as important as any policy in the positive impact produced by his presidency.
