BECOME A COUNCIL MEMBER OF THE CITY OF AMMON

As a citizen of Ammon, Idaho you can serve your community by becoming a city council member. You can also earn \$700 a month plus a benefit package starting at a \$1,454¹ per month saving. This includes medical, dental and vision insurance². You may also qualify for state sponsored life insurance and disability coverage³. Depending on your situation you may also be allowed to participate in a retirement program with an 11.94% wage matching through PERSI. You can become vested after only 5 months⁴ in your elected office! The Ammon personnel policy manual⁵ states you will receive 25 free swimming passes to the Ammon pool and 50% off of park and facility rentals.

WHAT HOURS MUST A COUNCIL MEMBER SPEND WORKING ON CITY ISSUES?

According to the City's Website⁶ there are two Council meetings each month (the first and third Thursday at 7 PM) and one work session on the second Thursday of each month at 4:30 PM. Each meeting can last from 30 minutes up to three hours. A former council member stated he was asked to only work 20 hours a month. And he believed many council members only put in the time for the three meetings per month when they had busy schedules.

IMMEDIATE ACTION IS REQUIRED . . .

This election is unique as four seats will be open for the election. Since there are 6 seats in total these 4 new members will have a critical influence in Ammon's future development as our city becomes more and more attractive to big developers like Flagship Homes(<https://www.forsail.com/>). Making the next few years a major turning point in Ammon's history as either a charming rural community or a crowded metropolis.

WHO CAN RUN FOR A COUNCIL MEMBER SEAT?

The only qualifications a candidate needs to run is to be 18 years or older and a resident of the City of Ammon. Meaning anyone in our fair city can live the American dream and become a city council member, no fancy degrees or graduates are required!
