Maple Syrup and Memories



On one of the record-breaking hottest days of June, St Mary's was delighted to have Michelle and John Michael (Mike) Martin visit us - all the way from British Columbia Canada.

Mike reached out to us back in October '25 about a visit he would be making :

"As part of a personal pilgrimage to explore my family's historical ties to your parish. My great-grandfather, William Martin (1815–1884), is pictured in a photograph displayed at the church, identified as the parish carpenter and clerk

who hung the church bells in 1867. Family records also suggest he built the parish lectern. Additionally, I've located two gravestones in the churchyard dated 1835 for John and Elizabeth Martin, believed to be my great-aunt and uncle. I'd love to confirm their burial locations and learn more about their lives if any parish records are available"

Julian Avis and Tony Turk very kindly came along and gave a fascinating insight between them to the history of the church, all things bell-ringing and Tony located and talked through the various "Martin" graves.

It was a sweltering day, but it was a fascinating

one and I certainly enjoyed my time with Mike, Michelle, Julian and Tony.



We all went to see the bells and the clock, and Julian gave our visitors a wonderful talk on the background of everything which also included mention of the fact that Mikes Great Grandfather as Carpenter - quite possibly also made some of the wooden structure housing the bells.



Mike was thrilled when he was given the opportunity to wind the clock a little which was fascinating.



On the way up for a peep outside at the stunning views from the top - they even got to meet our resident baby Pigeons on the tower steps - what more could you ask!



We were each presented with a lovely gift of genuine Canadian Maple Syrup and I am looking forward to mine on pancakes soon.....



Thank you Julian and Tony for making their visit a special one for them and one I am sure they will remember for a long time to come.

Here's a small excerpt from a mail they kindly sent before leaving for Canada.....


