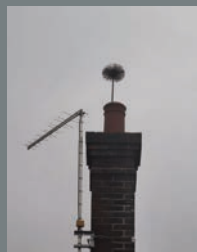

Martin's Murmurations

Dear Friends,

I had reason to travel to Sheffield recently to attend a memorial event for my wife's aunt who had died aged ninety - nine. I am sure she arranged her age to die because she was a staunch republican all her life and would not have wanted a royal birthday card. That is a pity because the image of the King and Queen on the cards show them to have very kindly faces. But Auntie Marjorie was committed to her principles to the end. She also enjoyed an argument and I once said she would be delighted to be sold stale bread at the local baker's so that she could go back and enjoy complaining! But in a strange kind of way she was very loveable as well as being capable of great kindness. A life - long spinster she nevertheless gained much pleasure in caring for two young ladies from Yemen. They came to call her 'auntie' and one of the things she did for them was to keep their passports hidden in her house so that their father could not rush them out to his homeland and force them into an arranged marriage. Though I suspect, given their independent nature and their feistiness, there are two very grateful Yemeni gentleman who, without knowing it, are in debt to Marjorie!

I came to be very conscious of the characteristics of what we call kindness on my trip. I came across so many people who went out of their way to help me. The hotel receptionist was a wonderful

character who greeted all the guests as if they were family and, whilst this lengthened the time in the queue to register, the sheer warmth of the women was a real tonic. On one of our evenings there we went to the oldest Indian restaurant in Sheffield which was founded in the sixties. The maitre d' was so kind in making sure we had comfortable seats and gently explained a menu full of exciting new dishes. Taxi drivers actually helped with luggage and the folk who organised the Memorial did so efficiently and with more than good grace.

When we began our journey home we reached Sheffield Railway Station only to find London bound trains were going no further than Bedford and off we went to find an information person on the

station's concourse. We found a gem of a human being. She contacted a colleague and between them worked out a route we could take. They signed our tickets to indicate that we were forced to change routes and I thought they had done a wonderful and helpful job. But their work was not done. We were escorted through underground passages not usually frequented by passengers to a staff lift and when we alighted the train to take us to Doncaster on the new route was waiting. We boarded the train and then another official came onto the train to deliver a print out of our revised journey with times and changes underlined. There was another note to any ticket inspector we might meet on the journey. Even on the journey we found kindness in a ticket collector who asked to see our tickets and I also showed him my senior rail card. "Oh I didn't ask for that sir you don't look old enough to have one. O blessed man thank you!!!!!!" came my reply. It had been a weekend where I had been shown such a depth of genuine kindness. I reflected on how blessed I had been. I realised how much easier my time had been and how little stress I had encountered because of people I will likely never see again. This should not really be worth a mention. Kindness should be part of our everyday human experience. But clearly it isn't. On our tv screens we see world leaders insulting people who they see as opponents, we see exchanges in the House of Commons where members seem to vie with one another as to who can make the cruellest comments about members of other parties.

Tando who was Marjorie's carer is a young woman from South Africa. She works shifts from seven in the morning to ten at night. She has thirty elderly people on her list. She feeds them, she takes care of their very personal hygiene as well as many other things. She told me not a day passes when she not is verbally abused. She tells me it really hurts. I can only feel anger for her not empathy with her because I do not know how she feels. Her world has dark spaces whilst on my weekend I was in a very bright space.

We need to look again at the virtue of kindness as well as its partner courtesy - to think again as to how healing both these things are not only to those we meet but also to ourselves. Think how much better we feel when we have performed a good, grace filled and kindly act to others compared to how we feel after treating someone with rudeness and unkindness. Rev Paul is on his holy walk on the road taken by the Celtic Saints of old. He is walking the path of Saints Columbus and Aidan as well as many other holy men and women. They all expressed their

faith by showing its fruits of love, joy and peace. It seems to me there is value in our looking afresh at the power of kindness and use it in our everyday dealings with others, A simple but powerful thing to do. In small acts of kindness we will witness a huge power of love. Love as Michael Ball once sang 'changes everything.' Why not give that sentiment both a try and a chance?

God bless you and those you love. May Our Father in heaven help you to show kindness in response to the next irritating person who comes your way. May you be an agent of the change the world needs.

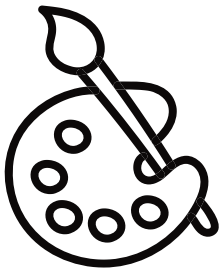

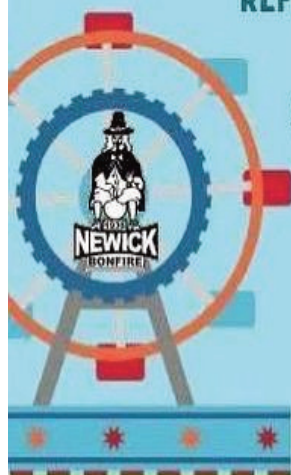

Newick Parish Council Update

Newick Parish Council Meeting – June 2025 Summary

The Newick Parish Council met on 9th June 2025 at the Community Centre, covering key local issues and decisions.

Community & Safety

- PCSO Rose Stainer discussed ongoing concerns about outbuilding burglaries, speeding, parking within the village and minor anti-social behaviour.
- 'Op Blitz' patrols have resumed for the summer weekends.

Planning Matters

- The Council objected to a revised application for two dwellings at Honeysuckle Cottage, Station Road.
- No comment was made on a change-of-use application for Rotherfield Wood Yard.
- A strong objection will be submitted against the proposed 1,700-home development at Owlsbury Farm due to concerns over infrastructure and traffic.

Finance & Grants

- The Council reviewed its budget and approved payments for June.
- A grant application from Action Against Abuse was declined, with a request for a revised proposal more relevant to Newick residents.
- Funding was approved for wildflower planting.

Village Improvements

- The Council discussed the naming of the Sports Pavilion with further discussions planned.
- Samples of the proposed outer cladding and patio surface for the Sports Pavilion were shown.
- Bench renovations are starting, with local craftsmen collaborating on the project.
- Provision of an additional pedestrian crossing in the vicinity of the Village Hall was discussed as this is a school bus drop-off point. LDC and ESCC will be contacted.

Upcoming Events & Initiatives

- A family day at Reedens Meadows is scheduled for 28th June.
- The Council will respond to several East Sussex consultations, including transport and local government reorganisation.
- The next Parish Council newsletter content was agreed upon.

The next meeting will take place in July, with discussions on the Sports Pavilion name and grounds maintenance contracts. For full minutes and updates, visit Newick Parish Council's website.



SNIPPETS OF NEWICK HISTORY BY ANTIQUARIUS

Postal service in Newick

The Newick Post Office commenced in the 1840s when it cost one penny to send a letter.

The 1855 *Post Office Directory for Sussex* shows the postmaster for Newick as being Elias Hurion Neve. He was also the village schoolmaster, a census enumerator, an assistant overseer collecting rates and, no doubt, able to read letters for those villagers unable to read.

One postman from the early 1900s was Martin Jenner, an old soldier who delivered his letters on a solid-tyred tricycle. Another was Albert Markwick, said to be the first man to be called up from Newick to go to the First World War. He mended boots and shoes in his spare time. He wore a high-crowned cap with a peak rather like a French kepi, his legs enclosed in blue puttees.

In the early 1900s the Newick Parish Council had pressed the postmaster to make appropriate provision for post boxes in the more scattered parts of Newick parish.

A local newspaper report from May 1932 regarding the speed of the postal service is illuminating....

'...The Lewes and District postal facilities were further improved by the introduction of a.....motor-cycle combination ...now serves Cooksbridge, South Common, Plumpton Green, Chailey and Newick. ...letters posted in London up to 11.30 am secure delivery the same afternoon...the Sunday rural collections are also performed by motor-cyclists and it is safe to say that the local postal facilities are now very expeditious, though every effort is still being made to effect further improvements...'

Picture postcard collectors will be familiar with sometimes finding postcards with the sender's message saying '*...will see you this afternoon*'...illustrating how remarkably fast the service was in those years gone by.

Post boxes in Newick include the Victorian one at Fletching Common with a Victoria Regina (VR) cypher at the top, and the one at Cornwells Bank with the George Rex (GR) cypher.

Important Update: Changes to how you can book urgent appointments

We recently reviewed our appointment data and found that many calls made at 8am for same-day appointments were actually for non-urgent issues. To help keep our phone lines free for patients with urgent needs, we've made a small but important change:

☎ **You can now book non-urgent appointments by phone after 10am**, or anytime via the **NHS App** or **Patient Access**. This update supports the Government's goal of reducing the early morning rush for appointments, often called the "8am scramble."

To help you understand the new process, we've answered some common questions below.

Don't worry— actually **not much has changed**, we've just increased the way appointments can be booked to make things easier for everyone.

This only applies to GP appointments. All other appointments have not changed.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What if I need an urgent appointment on the same day?

- ① Call us as usual from **8am** if you have an urgent issue.
- 📱 Our receptionist will send a triage link to your mobile phone/smart device, this link will take you to Visiba Care via your NHS App. If you do not have a mobile phone/smart device the receptionist will complete the triage link on your behalf, we also have a small number of appointments that the receptionist can book directly into where appropriate.

Q: What happens if my issue is urgent?

- If you have a mobile phone or tablet, we'll send you a link to complete a short **triage form**. This link will take you to the **NHS login**, where you'll fill in the triage form.

- The form goes directly to the **duty doctor**, who reviews **all requests** throughout the day.
- After reviewing your form, the surgery will contact you with next steps—either a same-day appointment or advice on booking for another day.

📞 Don't have a smartphone or tablet? Don't worry—our reception team will help you complete the triage process.

Q: Can I book an urgent appointment online?

Yes! The link is available from 8am to 6pm, Simply:

1. Visit newickhealthcentre.nhs.uk (this must be done via our website)
2. Click on **"Appointments"**
3. Select **"To request an urgent appointment..." or scan the QR code.**

This creates a link to the Visiba Triage form via the NHS Login. Click the button at the bottom.

4. Log in via the NHS Login and complete the Visiba triage form - this will follow the triage process above and the surgery will then contact you directly.

Need an Urgent Appointment Today but Don't Have a Mobile Phone?

- 📞 Don't worry—you still can – just call us or come in.
- We keep some urgent appointments available to book **through reception** for patients without a mobile phone.
- Or, if you prefer, the **reception team can complete the online form for you.**

● If you come to the desk, you may be asked to return home and we'll call you on your **landline** to complete the form—this helps keep your information private.

Not Confident With Online Forms or don't have a smart phone?

- 👉 That's okay. Our reception team is happy to help. They can:
 - Fill out the form **over the phone** with you (on your landline)
 - Guide you through the process step-by-step

Can I Still Book at the Reception Desk?

✓ Yes. There will still be **a limited number of appointments available at the desk**, especially for those without access to a mobile phone. Even if you do have a mobile, you can come to reception, and we'll send a booking link to your phone.

Booking Appointments – Made Easy

Q: Can I book a routine (non-urgent) appointment in advance?

✓ **Yes, absolutely!** If your issue isn't urgent, please call or visit reception **after 10am** to book a future appointment.

You can book ahead:

- **48 hours in advance**
- **1 week in advance**
- **Up to 6 weeks in advance**

You can also book online anytime via: **NHS App** (*download it from your app store*) or **Patient Access** (*ask at reception—ID is required to register*) –

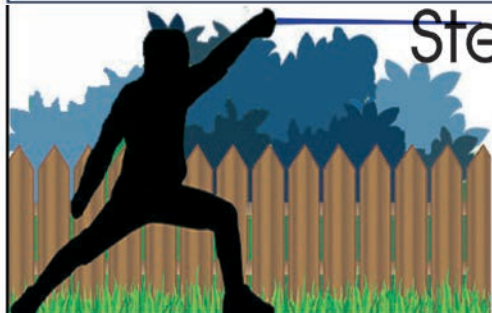
