



Rector's Ramblings

Dear Friends,

Welcome to the November edition of St Mary's Newick's Church and Community Magazine.

As October draws to a close and November begins, this sees the height of the Bonfire season, with Newick Bonfire on the 2nd November and Chailey Bonfire on the 9th November with Lewes sandwiched in between the two. This is a special time of year for many Sussex villages when we remember the capture of Guy Fawkes on 5th November 1605 and the arrest of his fellow conspirators, hell bent on creating chaos and anarchy across our country and beyond.

One wonders, however, had the state of the time encouraged greater tolerance of shared beliefs over the years, rather than intolerance and persecution, if the conspirators would have felt the need to try to dissolve both King and Parliament in such a drastic and permanent way?

It is always interesting to think about the context of our 'remembering'. I was talking with some of NYC crew the other evening, and we were talking about how we liked the old NBS t-shirts with the picture of the Plotters and underneath the words "Come back Guy Fawkes, all is forgiven". One of the lads then said,

"Guy Fawkes, Guy Fawkes'
twas his intent
To blow up the King and the
Parliament,
Three Score Drones he sent above
Knocked out over Sussex
Coz we wun't be druy"

I must confess, I was rather impressed, even if it was very poignant!

We stand this year in a world divided on so many levels, perhaps our celebrations and remembrances this year can be focused on what unites us, rather than what divides us.

Of course, there is also our national act of Remembrance, this month on Remembrance Sunday on the 10th and on Armistice Day on the 11th November.

Rector's Ramblings - continued

As the grandson of a man who served in the 1st Battalion Expeditionary Force Royal Sussex Regiment, and lost his life during the Battle of El Alamein in 1942, I never fail to be moved as the poppies fall down from the roof of the Royal Albert Hall during the Festival of Remembrance.

That remembrance is all the more poignant in our own day as the reality of war and its human cost is once again apparent.

On Remembrance Day the nations around the world stand still (metaphorically speaking at least) for two minutes to remember those, to borrow a phrase from St Paul, who were prepared to "stand firm and hold fast" against evil atrocities that would seek to impose an alternative governance structure, that would demean and dehumanize generations of those yet unborn. There is no doubt in my mind that resisting evil is good, just and morally courageous; so this is in no way a call for pacifism.

Along with hundreds of thousands of others, I am grateful for the men, women and children (many under age) who volunteered to serve in the first world war, who in conflicts throughout the years, have chosen to serve their nation and to defend what is right and good. And, if I'm really honest, I have spent much of my life simply wondering what the impact would be on me of being 'called to serve my country'.

When I had the huge privilege of visiting the Normandy beaches with a group of school Dads from Newick & Chailey, back in September, I wondered how I would have reacted to the chaos and carnage of those Normandy landings.

This November there will be services at war memorials and in churches across the United Kingdom and across the world, as we remember those who died fighting to protect us and bring peace and justice to our world, and we pray for those serving in our Armed Forces today.

Memories, and remembering, are such central parts of our personalities and character, and in many ways make up part of who we are. Being remembered is very important to us, and the thought that we might be forgotten can be heart-breaking.

I often read these verses from Isaiah to people who are feeling lost and abandoned for any reason, or who are grieving the passing of years which means that all those whom they knew and loved, and who held the memories of them as younger people, have died:

Rector's Ramblings - continued

"Behold, God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them, as their God. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain for the old order of things has passed away"

Isaiah 25:19

For Christians, of course, the most significant act of remembering is when we come together to remember in bread and wine the death and resurrection of Jesus. Jesus' willing sacrifice of himself on the cross for the sake of others is, for Christian believers, the ultimate expression of the self-giving love at the heart of God, when Christ's hands were marked by the nails of the cross.

"Do this in remembrance of me."

So in this season of Remembrance, as we remember with candles, poppies, or bread and wine, may we all take time to pause, reflect, and be thankful.

Shopping on the Rialto in Renaissance Venice: Antonia Garward-Cevizli

How about a little shopping? Come to Venice with us to visit the Rialto Bridge and the market beyond. We will be going back in time to the 16th Century but in fact little has changed. The first bridge was built of wood and, apart from burning down on various occasions it also totally collapsed during the celebrations for a wedding ceremony. Not surprisingly it was decided to build a stone bridge and in 1591 the present bridge was completed and built entirely of marble. It also continued to have shops on either side which now sell the famous Venetian glassware, masks and linen. The bridge is also called 'the Lovers Bridge' as legend promises eternal love if lovers kiss under the bridge at the exact time the sun sets!

Antonia spent a year at the University of Siena Statale and also lived in Venice. However, her interests are wide-ranging. She has lectured on 15th-century Italian art for the Victoria and Albert Museum and taught Modern Art from Impressionism to Pop at Sabancı University, Istanbul. She has worked as a gallery lecturer at Tate Modern and Tate Britain for a number of years

Anecdotes from a Pest Controller



It shouldn't happen at a dinner party

I write my words of wisdom today from the dog house, after putting my feet squarely in it with my dear wife. We had a dinner party a short while ago when one of my female guests asked me which I considered the worst pest that I had dealt with. I had indulged in a small amount of libation by this point, which caused me to re-tell a story that has stayed with me from my early days in pest control. You might describe it as a 'Tale of Toe' as the story involves a tramp who was taken to hospital with swollen feet and anaemia. On investigation, the doctors found bed bugs in his boots and crammed under his toenails.

I explained to my guests that, the bed bug (Climex Lectularius) is 4-5mm in length, wingless and it is a mahogany colour. The females lay 400-500 eggs in their lifetime.

A nymph hatches from the egg after approximately 10 days. It is a small version of the adult. It sheds its skin 5 times before it becomes full size. They feed on blood throughout their life. After feeding they move away from the host to rest during the day. If there is not a food source available they can 'sleep' for 12 months.

The signs of infestation are blood spots on bedding, mattresses, around skirting boards and other fixtures and fittings. They do not transmit diseases when feeding, though they have been known to cause anaemia and secondary infection. The feeding causes red bite marks and irritation, usually centered on the stomach area and other sensitive areas.

I then made an even bigger mistake of producing a sample of bed bugs, freshly frozen from the same freezer that my wife had taken ice cream from moments earlier. It was only at this point that I noticed that everyone had stopped eating and my wife's eyes were burning a hole right through me. I'm sure Sarah will forgive me soon!

Sleep well, don't let the bed bugs bite!

SNIPPETS OF NEWICK HISTORY BY ANTIQUARIUS

Lady Vernon

In the church, the stone memorial plaque to Louisa Barbara Lady Vernon includes these words 'To the memory of L B Lady Vernon, wife of G V Lord Vernon...She was religious charitable and ingenious, endowed with many virtues; and with many accomplishments for amusement and society. She died February 16th 1786, aged 53, ever to be regretted by the poor of this parish'

The couple lived at Newick Park and in 1771 at the age of 39 Louisa provided a school for girls at Fount Hill. Joyce Lindsey, in her book 'Newick -The Story of a Sussex Village' (1983) states '...What a sensation this must have caused in the village! Education was rare for any but the gentry and here was her Ladyship giving it free to village girls...' The school remained in use until 1926 and Louisa's legacy still continues as the Lady Vernon Educational Trust.

This is all admirable but there is sadness as well. Lady Vernon endured the heartache of three of her four children dying as infants. Then the marriage broke down, with a 'deed of separation' because of the 'great differences and discontent' between the couple. Louisa's husband chose to live at his family seat in Derbyshire with their remaining child, whilst Louisa stayed in Newick Park and later in Wales. The reason for the breakdown of the marriage becomes clear in the will of Lady Vernon...

'...The reason of my taking but little notice of my near relations is because they have never thought fit to assist me in my troubles or ever made a point of my getting my child. Mr Vernon is the sole cause of his child being disinherited for which she has reason to bless him and the true reason of my parting with him which I now make known to the world was his

attachment and intimacy with Mrs Brown, his daughter's maid, which many now testify the truth of in Sussex and other intimacies well known but more supportable in measure than this but I hope it will be forgiven in the next world...'


