#### Introduction

Sramajibi Academy of Nursing is an initiative of Belur Sramajibi Swasthya Prakalpa Samity. Belur Sramajibi Swasthya Prakalpa Samity is registered under Society Registration Act in the year 1992, having its head office at 5, GT Road, Belur, Howrah, 711202. Our society runs two multi-speciality hospitals, one 60 bedded at Belur, Howrah and another 100 bedded at Serampore, Hooghly. In the time of COVID-19 pandemic we have successfully run Level IV, COVID hospital in Serampore. We have a Blood Bank with component separator facility at our Serampore campus. We have established our academic campus Sramajibi Pathshala at 104/A Dewangazi Road, Bally, Howrah, 711201, on a stretch of land donated by three sisters. We earned affiliation from Ministry of Health & Family Welfare-Govt. of West Bengal, West Bengal Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council to start and run a school of nursing and got permission to admit 60 students for GNM (General Nursing and Midwifery) course for the academic session 2019 - 2022. This permission continued in 2020 -2023, 2021-2024, 2022-2025 and 2023-2026 sessions also. Our students are getting trained not only in our 100 beded parent hospital at Serampore but also at College of Medicine and Sagore Dutta Hospital as well as at Walsh Hospital-Serampore, TL Jaiswal Hospital-Howrah, District Hospital-Howrah. For their experience in Community Health, they visit field area under Rural Hospital Domjur. We regularly conduct seminar and workshop by eminent personal in the field of health. We conduct regular cultural programs in the campus and take the students in the academic excursion. Students participate in the Yoga class and in annual sports. Our society delivers quality health care and education at just cost on no profit no loss basis to the underprivileged sections of the community. We want to continue on the same note on our new endeavor.

## **Anti-ragging Policy**

## **RAGGING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITTED**

- 1. We observe zero tolerance on ragging.
- 2. We follow UGC and INC guideline to address ragging.
- 3. We have anti-ragging committee, anti-ragging squad and mentoring cell.
- 4. Every student during admission has to give undertaking in the form of affidavit for making ragging free campus.

## **Grievance and redressal policy**

- 1. Students are free to submit any grievance to teacher, Vice Principal, Principal or to Academic Council directly, either verbally or in writing.
- 2. All grievances are to be discussed in academic council and if not solved, in executive committee of the society.

### Rules and regulations

#### a. General

- Academy will strictly follow rules and regulations of WBNC and INC regarding minimum requirement of attendance for the course and eligibility for examinations.
- ii. Students have to be in the uniform in classes, clinics, hospital wards and in community.
- iii. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited during teaching, training and duty hours.

#### b. Hostel rules

- i. Valuables are not allowed in the hostel.
- ii. Responsibility to keep belongings safe lies with the owner.
- iii. Articles belong to the academy are to be handed over to the authority before issuance of clearance certificate.
- iv. Right of allotment of rooms and beds lie with academy authority.
- v. Kitchen, dining hall and cleaning duty is to be done as per schedule prepared by academy authority.
- vi. Personal electrical appliances are not allowed in the hostel.
- vii. Use of candle, agarbati or any other source of fire is strictly prohibited.
- viii. Visitors are allowed in the visitors' room only during visiting hours.
- ix. No student is allowed to leave hostel between 9pm and 6am.
- x. Prior permission to be taken for night pass.
- xi. Substance abuse (tobacco, alcohol, drugs) are strictly prohibited.
- xii. Any deviation to these rules to be strictly dealt with.

#### c. Sickness rules

- i. Sickness to be reported immediately.
- ii. Medical advice during illness to be followed strictly.
- iii. No self-medication is permitted.

#### d. Leave & absenteeism rules

- i. Students must adhere to the leave rules of the academy, WBNC and INC.
- ii. Students have to take prior permission for any leave.
- iii. All absenteeism has to be authenticated with proper certification medical or other and counter signed by guardian. Duties during absent days are to be done in addition to regular duties.
- iv. Absenteeism are delt as per the instruction of WBNC and INC.

#### e. Library rules

- i. Students may borrow one book at a time and keep it for a week.
- ii. Late fine@Rs.5/-per day per book will be charged if they fail to return within stipulated time.
- iii. Issued books if damaged or lost are to be replaced by the student.
