

We have a limit of 48 children in the facility at a time. Spots are held on a first-come, first-serve basis.



How to Register:

Download the Super Ninja Zone Summer Camp 2024 Registration packet.

Fill out all necessary information. Email a photocopy to

Nicole@SuperNinjaZone.com or submit in person.

After submitting, we will add your child to the roster. We will notify you via email if you have accepted or waitlisted.

Child Eligibility Requirements:

- Children must be between the ages of 6 and 14, or Ages 5 must be turning 6 by September 1st 2024 in order to attend.
- Children ages 5 turning 6 must have completed their first year of kindergarten in order to attend.
- Children are required to be able to use the restroom on their own.
- Children are required to be able to change their clothes on their own.
- Children are required to be fully potty trained.
- Children must have the ability to walk a mile.
- Children must have the ability to hold themselves up on the obstacles.

Age Groups:

Children will be divided into age groups for activities.

Age Groups: Ages 5 to 9 and 10 to 14

<u>Charges:</u>

- If you are not paying in full at the time of registration, payments must be made by the Monday prior (7 days) to the child's scheduled week of camp.
- If the child is scheduled for a single day within the week of camp, the
 payment for that day still must be made the Monday prior to the start date
 of the week that's within the chosen day(s) of camp. (E.g. Child is scheduled
 for a Wednesday, payment must be made 9 days prior on the Monday the
 week before)
- The child will not be able to attend unless payment is made 1 week prior. No same-day payments.
- It is the responsibility of the payee to make the payment on time without email/text reminders.
- A charge card must be kept on file in the event a child is not picked up on time, does not have a lunch packed, or causes severe damage to the equipment.

ADDTIONAL INFORMATION

Attire and What to Bring:

- Please bring a water bottle
- Please bring your own sunscreen. Must sign a sunscreen waiver to have a counselor help apply sunscreen to your child.
- Please wear athletic shoes and clothes
- A packed lunch and 1 snack for half-day, 2 snacks for all day campers.
- An extra change of clothes in case your child gets dirty at the park or during arts and crafts
- Parks have wading pools. if your child would like to swim, please have them bring a swimsuit and a towel inside of a book bag.
- Please label all bags with the child's first and last name.

Pick Up and Drop Off

- Parent/Approved person (from registration) is allowed to drop off/ pick up their child.
- Children must be signed in and out daily.
- Children are not allowed to leave the facility/group under any circumstances.

Counselor Information:

- All camp counselors are CPR and First Aid Certified
- Counselors are High School/College students who are interviewed and screened.
- Camp Counselor to Child Ratio is 1:12.
- All Camp Counselors are age 15 and older.

Field Trips:

Field Trips are within walking distance to Lions Park in Cuyahoga Falls All age groups walk together. The buddy system will be used. Attendance and a head count will be conducted before leaving the facility, upon arrival to the park, before leaving the park, and upon returning to the facility. The park is within 1 mile of the facility. Only routes on side streets with sidewalks will be used. if you do not wish to have your child attend the park field trip, please check "do not give permission" on your registration. There is a high possibility that we will not have an extra staff member to accommodate having 1 child stay back at the facility while the rest are at the park. In the event this happens, no one will go to the park.

ADDTIONAL INFORMATION

Rules:

Please review these rules with your children before attending camp.

- No bullying or harassment of any kind
- No weapons of any kind
- No play/pretend weapons
- No disrespect to Camp Counselors
- No damaging or taking Super Ninja Zone property
- No damaging or taking fellow camper's property
- Hands to yourself, no touching, grabbing, wrestling, or any physical contact toward other campers or counselors
- No foul language
- No leaving the group or the premises unless signed out by a parent/guardian

Breaking the rules of any kind will constitute the following consequences based on severity:

- 1. A verbal warning
- 2. A phone call to the parent/guardian
- 3. No field trip participation
- 4. No games/activities participation
- 5. A 1-Day suspension without a refund
- 6. A week-long suspension without a refund
- 7. A season-long suspension
- 8. A permanent ban from Super Ninja Zone

Refunds

- Refunds are available in the event of sickness/illness
- Refunds are available in the event of an on-site injury that prevents the camper from participating
- No refunds for misbehavior that results in a suspension or early release.
- No refunds for no-call/no-show campers
- No refunds for lack of participation
