June – No monthly challenge, Scavenger Hunt results

July - “**TRANSPORTATION**” - Many modes to choose from: airplanes, trains, cars, motorcycles, bicycles, etc, or your favorite car. As always - Be Creative!

August - “**SUNSETS**” - Include other things in the sky such as clouds, aircraft, birds, the Moon, also foregrounds: trees, water, rural or city landscapes, famous landmarks, etc, etc. Make it interesting.

September – **BLACK and WHITE** – Either shoot your picture in B&W or convert a color image with post-processing software. Utilize the “Zone System,” in your image which goes from zero (black) to ten (white).

October – “**SOMETHING OLD**” – LOTS of things to choose from!!!

November – “**ARCHIVE FAVORITES**” – Here’s a chance to dig out an image from your Photo archives of anything you would like to share with the club.

December – “**ORNAMENTS**” – Indoor, outdoor, day or nighttime.
