#### **Old Business**

- Buoys were placed in the lake. The missing buoy was found!
- Sunfish stocking complete 1,500 sunfish
  - The quality of the sunfish we purchased this year was very good they were in the 6"-8" range.
  - This is especially beneficial because the small mouth bass likely won't eat this size sunfish.
- In years past we typically received 2"-3" sunfish so this was a big improvement.
- Walleye fry stocking complete 50,000 fry
- Spent \$2,150 on fish stocking this spring
  - We received a much better value this year. We were prepared to spend the full allocation of fish funds but we received great quality fish and were invoiced less than previous years. Great fish for less money!
  - Saved the extra funds to spend on fish next year after the carp harvest is complete.
  - Louis checked on jumbo perch Rademacher didn't have anything available. No specific species of Jumbo Perch – the size of the fish depends on the vegetation in the lake. The perch are large in western Minnesota because they eat the large population of freshwater shrimp.

### Discuss Carp Removal

- Louis called a Carp Removal Specialist in Minneapolis based on a suggestion from a member. This specialist in Minneapolis is the facilitator and he hires the same commercial fisherman to harvest carp as we had planned to use the past few winters.
- We decided not to pursue hiring another commercial fisherman we will wait for him to harvest the carp this winter at no charge.
