5 THINGS YOU DIDN'T KNOW ABOUT TERRY GOLD AND "CRICKET"



Most Folsom residents have heard of the Folsom Valley Railway. We hope that most parents and their children have even ridden on it!

The Folsom Valley Railway features Cricket, a 12" 1/3 scale narrow gauge locomotive that is the only one of this size still in operation in the country. The railway has a bit less than a mile of track that meanders throughout the Folsom City Park and the Folsom Zoo. Cricket is engineered, driven and managed by Terry Gold.

Well, I bet there are some things that you didn't know about Terry and his Cricket. Because talking about Terry without including Cricket would be like, well, talking about only half of Terry.

- 1 Terry has owned Cricket now for 24 of his 54 years.
- 2 Terry has spent \$50k on the locomotive alone to keep Cricket in tip-top shape.
- 3 Cricket is one of only 10 actual steam-powered locomotives in the nation.
- 4 He drives Cricket for a living because he loves kids so much.
- 5 Terry first drove a train while working at Disneyland.
