

cozy spaces for two to more roomy spas for the entire family, (with an average size four-person spa measuring approximately $2m \times 2m$).

A spa may be a bit of a "luxury" item and a patio set is a necessity, but a barbecue falls somewhere in between - it's definitely a very nice thing to have, but you could live without it (if you absolutely had to)! I honestly don't think I've ever met anyone who doesn't barbecue in the summer - even if it's just on a single-grill charcoal hibachi. Charcoal grills are best known for producing intense, smoky flavors, and are the least expensive type of grill - usually \$100 or less. However, they are a start-up and clean-up nightmare, and they burn less cleanly than gas. They are also harder to regulate. Gas grills are easy to start, warm up quickly, and cook predictably. They range in price from about \$100 to over \$2,000. Electric grills start easily, offer precise temperature control

and allow you to grill with nonstick cookware, but can take a bit longer than gas to warm up and grill. They are generally priced from about \$100 to \$300 and are a good option for places where gas grills aren't allowed. Those looking for a backyard status symbol can easily find models that cost thousands of dollars and include step-up features such as stainless-steel exteriors and grates, separately controlled side burners, rotisserie attachments, utensil holders, and other perks.
