This new Broadstone Marketplace storefront provides supplies for two of the most popular crafts right now - scrap booking and quilting. They may appear to be at the opposite end of the craft spectrum from each other, but owner Suzie Peterson says there is actually quite a bit of overlap when it comes to some of the techniques and color concepts. The actual supplies are even starting to cross the line. For example, there is now a stiffened fabric that can be used in scrapbook pages.

For you quilters, they offer high-end "quilting quality" fabric in bright and whimsical prints, such as florals and batiks, and they carry a lot of flannels. If you don't see what you want in the store, they can also special order a fabric for you. For you scrap bookers, they pride themselves in offering over 1000 different types of paper, as well as embellishments and the Bazzil Basics Line, plus lots more.

Scrap Everything also offers technique, as well as just-for-fun scrap booking and quilting classes for all levels of experience. Their "Girls Night Out," every Friday and Saturday, is (ladies, hold on to your glue sticks and needles) free! Their die cut machine, with up to 20 different fonts to choose from, is available for your use at these functions.

Suzie, an artsy/craftsy type herself, totally believes in "treating people the way you want to be treated." She hires people who have the same philosophy, and the entire staff operates to please. "Customers and service come first," she says. They even take returns, which, from what I understand about the craft world, is a rarity.
