DRESSING ROOMS + HOSPITALITY

Dressing rooms, touring, production and administration offices are located in the lower level with direct access to the stage. Lower level access is exclusively from the north entrance (talent only), and from the south stage right entrance.

- (3) 250 sq' dressing rooms 25' x 10'
- (1) bathroom with vanity and toilet 6.5 x 5'
- (1) shower room 6.5' x 5' with sink & wall mirror, 12' x 12' attached changing room with wall mirror
- (1) tour manager area with printer access
- (1) 720 sq' lounge/ dining / common area (36' x 20')
- Full kitchen
- Beverage bar
- Snack bar
- (1) washer and (1) dryer for artists and crew to use
- Wi-Fi available throughout building (no hard-wired internet)

MERCHANDISE

- Merchandise area is 20' wide and located inside the performance room, near an emergency exit.
- This area is equipped with:
 - Wall grids
 - 2 8' covered tables (black Lycra stretch)
 - · Lighting for merchandise displays
 - Trash cans

STAGE + LOAD-IN

- Load in through 6' wide overhead door directly to the stage
- Stage deck: 20' wide x 20' deep x 4' tall
- Stage right: 12' wide x 12' deep. In addition 4' wide x 20' deep emergency exit lane
- Height over stage 11'
- Fly bar (for backdrops only): 15' wide, centered upstage in front of the curtain
- No rigging there is no grid above the stage

STAGE POWER

- (1) 100 amp 1P 120v, upstage right
- (1) 200 amp 1P 120v, upstage right
- (1) 600 amp 3P 208v, 240v or 460v, upstage right (advance to select voltage & install cable run)

AUDIO

FRONT OF HOUSE

- Located approximately 36' from downstage edge
- Dimensions: 10' x 6' deep (shared with lighting)
- Platform is cantilevered off the mezzanine level
- Patrons are prohibited from entering the FOH area by affixed railing and gate

FOH CONSOLE AND I/O

- Console: Behringer X32
- I/0: Behringer S32 (32 in/ 16 out)
- Outputs: Left, Right, Mono Sub, Mono Front Fill
- Drive lines at FOH console

- FOH position located approximately 36' from downstage edge
- Dimensions: 10' x 6' deep (shared with audio)
- Platform is cantilevered off the mezzanine level
- Patrons are prohibited from entering the FOH area by installed railing and gate

^{*} HAZERS, FOGGERS, AND OTHER SMOKE/PYRO: Due to our fire suppression and HVAC systems conforming to newer building codes, you must use the house hazer, which is under the venue LD's control. This is non-negotiable

^{*} CONFETTI, TOILET PAPER, ETC: A clean-up fee of \$250 may be assessed for confetti, toilet paper and similar products. Please discuss specifics of your show and fee with venue house manager.

PARKING & LOAD-IN

Our parking area is very specific. Parking arrangements will be confirmed after talking with our Production Manager.

LOAD-IN | TEMPORARY PARKING (see graphic on the next page)

Load-in is temporary parking. Once equipment is unloaded, vehicle(s) will be moved to permanent parking for show.

WHEN TRAVELING FROM THE EAST

• Take Chestnut Expressway to Jefferson St. and take a left

WHEN TRAVELING FROM THE WEST

• Take Chestnut Expressway to Jefferson St. and take a right

IF VEHICLE LENGTH (INCLUDING TRAILER) IS LESS THAN 30'

- Take Jefferson St. to Park Central East and turn right
- From Park Central East, take 1st right onto Robberson Ave (small alleyway)
- Immediately pull as close as possible against the red brick building on your right, between the power poles. Pull up enough that the back of your rig is off the sidewalk. (see "A" on graphic)
 - Unload will occur there, roll cases west on the sidewalk approx. 80' through the sidewalk patio rolling gate, through the overhead door, and onto the stage. (see "E" on graphic)

IF VEHICLE LENGTH (INCLUDING TRAILER) IS MORE THAN 30'

- Take Jefferson St. to Elm St. and turn right
- From Elm St., take 2st right onto Robberson Ave (small alleyway)
- Take Robberson Ave, crossing Pershing St., Walnut St., McDaniel St. and Park Central East
- Immediately after crossing Park Central East pull over as close as possible against the red brick building on your right and between the power poles. Pull up so back of your rig is off the sidewalk. (see "A" on graphic)
 - Unload will occur there, roll cases west on the sidewalk approx. 40' through the sidewalk patio rolling gate, through the overhead door, and onto the stage. (see "E" on graphic)

IF VEHICLE EMITTING EXHAUST AND YOU'RE UNABLE TO TURN IT OFF, PULL FORWARD TO "B" on graphic IF DRIVER MUST LEAVE PRIOR TO UNLOAD, GO STRAIGHT TO OLIVE ST (see "C" on graphic) AND PUSH FROM THERE

SHOW PARKING

OPTION 1 (see "C" on graphic)

- After unloading, take Robberson Ave to the next cross street (Olive St.)
- Turn left on Olive St.
- Immediately pull over to the right against the curb and park.

OPTION 2 (see "D" on graphic)

- Turn right on Olive Street
- Immediately turn right again into the 'Holland Building Parking Lot'
- Proceed on parking lane and navigate half-way through left turn circle drive pulling against red brick building 307
- Back-up with rear of vehicle parking close to green ground transformer
- Front of vehicle will be within 5' to 12' of single 40" glass door of red brick building (talent and staff only entrance)
- There is space for up to two buses and trailers side-by-side.
