

Dr. Curtis received her medical degree from the University of North Carolina School of Medicine Chapel Hill. She completed a residency in radiation oncology training at Baylor College of Medicine. At Baylor, she was named Naresh Prashad Scholar, an award for the highest academic achievement in the Department of Radiology.

Dr. Curtis is a member of the American Medical Association, American College of Radiology, and the American Society for Therapeutic Radiology and Oncology.

Dr. VK Gadi was named the Cancer Center Deputy Director in 2022. Dr. Gadi, whose laboratory and clinical research has focused primarily on breast cancer, joined the Cancer Center in 2020 as Associate Director of Translational Medicine when he came to the University of Illinois Chicago (UIC) after 20 years in Seattle at the University of Washington, where he did his postgraduate training, and the Fred Hutch Cancer Center.

Working closely with Cancer Center leadership, Dr. Gadi continues to lead efforts to identify and recruit novel molecular assets for clinical trials testing from both big pharmaceutical companies and smaller biotech.

Dr. Gadi's efforts have increased national-level engagement for cooperative group studies and provided access to Cancer Center disease team leaders for clinical trial development opportunities to ensure trials are written to address the needs of diverse patient populations.

In collaboration with several groups of investigators and UIC technology transfer, Dr. Gadi also is accelerating the process of commercialization of multiple diagnostic and therapeutic intellectual properties to build a sustainable licensing revenue stream to support Cancer Center activities.

Dr. Robert D. Siegel is an oncologist in Greenville, South Carolina and is affiliated with <u>Bon Secours St. Francis Health System-Greenville</u>. He received his medical degree from Columbia University Vagelos College of Physicians and Surgeons and has been in practice for more than 20 years. Dr. Robert D. Siegel has expertise in treating lymphoma, lung cancer, prostate cancer, among other conditions.



Dr. Nasfat ShehadehAttending Hematologist and Medical Oncologist

Dr. Shehadeh has been voted a top doctor in medical oncology for years 2019-2022 by Charlotte Magazine. He graduated from the medical school at Jordan University of Science and Technology in Irbid, Jordan with honors on the Dean's list. After his residency and fellowship at Wayne State University in Detroit, he held various academic appointments as a fellow and professor at the University of Minnesota, Karmanos Cancer Institute in Detroit, and University of Toledo.

Dr. Nasfat Shehadeh is board certified in Hematology, Medical Oncology,

Before serving cancer patients in Charlotte, he was the medical director at Mercy Cancer Centers in Toledo and an Assistant Professor of Medicine at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis. He and his family migrated south when he took on the clinical role of developing a cancer program with Novant Health Cancer Specialists starting in 2015. In 2020, Dr. Shehadeh joined the oncology team at OSC. Having worked previously in a hospital-based cancer program, he has seen the vast difference of personalized care that can be obtained in an independent oncology practice. The setting is patient-focused with access to care that is broadened across all the hospital systems and not being limited to just one.

Dr. Shehadeh brings a range of clinical expertise in all areas of solid tumor and blood diseases. He has overseen many clinical research trials in various cancer therapies, including immunotherapy, metastasized cellular structure, stem cell transplant, and blood disorders, to name a few. In the past few years he has been presenting to various cancer groups on specific topics in lung cancer, breast cancer, clinical trials, colon cancer, and multiple myeloma. He is a member of the American Society of Clinical Oncology, Community Oncology Alliance, and locally the Independent Physicians of the Carolinas.




Judith L. Pearson
