

NSW Pinto Horse Association Inc High Point

The Committee are excited to announce we are implementing High Point Awards to reward our members who are actively out campaigning their Pintos not only in Pinto classes at Agricultural shows, but also in open classes/competitions. All horses **MUST** to be registered with the **Pinto Horse Association of NSW Inc** and the owners **MUST be current Financial members** to be eligible.

There will be **NO** nomination fee however we will need you to be responsible for submitting your points to our allocated Point Score Officer via email within 2 weeks of your competition. Points will still be able to be submitted after this time however we require a \$20 fee. Points will **NOT** be counted if submitted later than four (4) weeks after your competition.

All forms must be filled in correctly or a \$20 fee will be charged. If still submitted incorrectly points **WILL NOT** count.

Failure to pay incorrect paperwork fee or lodged late fee will result in a forfeit of eligibility for the current competition.

We realise there are a lot of different disciplines for people to compete in these days, so have tried to create a category to cater for everyone. For now, we are going to offer the following:

- 1) Highpoint Led/ Halter Horse of NSW
- 2) High Point English Performance Horse of NSW
- 3) High Point Western Horse of NSW
- 4) High Point Utility Horse of NSW.

(The categories are explained in detail below)

To make it fair for all competitors in all areas of NSW, points will be allocated according to the number of entries in your class as shown in the table below.

Supreme Champion, Champion and Reserve Champions will be counted in the same manner as shown in the table.

If you attend the Pinto NSW National Show you will receive triple points.

If you attend any show run by the Pinto Horse Association of NSW you will receive double points.

If you attend a Royal Show you will receive double points.

All other shows will receive normal points as shown in the table above.

Winners will be announced at the BBQ held at the National Show.

The highpoint season will run from 1 August until 31 July each year.

We will be able to check with show societies if there is a discrepancy with points, so we are requesting you are honest with the information you supply. If you are found guilty of supplying false information this will result in a \$50 fine, and you will be disqualified from the High Point competition for the rest of the current show year.

A winner and Runner Up will be awarded prizes for each category.

Winners will receive the following:

- 1 x free membership for the following year
- 1 x Sign Your Neigh'm embroidered Halter
- 1 x NSW Pinto Horse Association embroidered shirt
- 1 x framed High Point Winner certificate

Runners Up will be awarded the following:

- 1 x free membership for the following year
- 1 x NSW Pinto Horse Association embroidered shirt
- 1 x framed High Point Runner up Certificate

High Point Led/Halter Horse

This is for all registered Pinto NSW Inc horses who compete in Pinto Breed Led Classes at Agricultural or Breed shows. For example, Luddenham Show or Hawkesbury Winter Show. As well as shows like the Youngstock Show held by the Welsh Pony and Cob Society.

- All led pinto classes will be eligible.
- No Other breed classes will count in this section.

High Point English Performance Horse

All horses competing as a registered Pinto of NSW Inc will gain points from any competition which is not closed to a breed for example, dressage at a Paint State or National show **WILL NOT** be counted however an open dressage day run by a dressage club **WILL** count.

All Pinto National Show results **WILL** be counted.

English classes include:

- Dressage
- Hacking – Led and Ridden
- Show Hunters – Led and Ridden (not western Hunter Under Saddle)

High Point Western Performance Horse

All horses competing as a registered Pinto of NSW Inc will gain points from any competition which is not closed to a breed for example, Western Pleasure at a Paint State or Paint National show **WILL NOT** be counted however any classes at an open club show for example, Sydney Regional Appaloosa Club and Sydney Quarter Horse Club shows **WILL** count.

All Pinto National Show results **WILL** be counted.

Western Classes include:

- Western Pleasure
- Western Horsemanship
- Western Riding
- Hunter Under Saddle (western)
- Hunt Seat Equitation
- Hunter In Hand
- Showmanship

High Point Utility Horse

All horses competing as a registered Pinto of NSW Inc will gain points from any competition which is not closed to a breed for example, dressage at a Paint State or Paint National show **WILL NOT** be counted however an open competition day by an independent association for example Ranch Horse Australia or Barrel Horse Australia **WILL** count.

All Pinto National Show results **WILL** be counted.

Utility Classes include:

- Working Equitation
- Campdrafting
- Sporting
- Working Equitation
- Ranch Horse
- Reining
- Carriage Horses
- Team Sorting

If you compete in a discipline not mentioned in any of the above categories, please contact a committee member of the Pinto Horse Association of NSW.
