IS MY HORSE ELIGIBLE TO BE REGISTERED PINTO?



A Pinto Stands Out In A Crowd

Is your horse a riding type with patches of white and any other colour on its body?

Are both of your horses parents registered with a recognised horse breed association? (geldings are exempt from this requirement)

Quality mares with body patches but no proven breeding may be eligible for registration under "The hardship Clause". You would need to send in your application form, four photos, vet certificate, proof of ownership and the appropriate fee to committee for consideration. This does not necessarily mean that the mare will be accepted, in the event that the horse was not accepted, the associated fee would be reimbursed to you.

Horses with Appaloosa/Palouse or Standardbred ancestry are not eligible for registration with the Pinto Horse Association of NSW inc.

Draught horses are not eligible for registration with the Pinto Horse Association of NSW Inc.
