2022 Fine Arts Hall of Fame Scholarships

The following scholarships are available through the Waxahachie Ex-Students' Association Fine Arts Hall of Fame. All students must be graduating seniors of Waxahachie Independent School District and have plans to further pursue education and/or training in fine arts. Applicant may apply for any and all Ex-Student Association scholarships however only one may be awarded.

Please indicate below which scholarships you would like to be considered for. As an applicant, you may apply for as many as you qualify for however, only one scholarship from the Ex-Students' Association may be received.

- \$1,250.00 **Fine Arts Hall of Fame Scholarship.** Applicant must pursue education and/or training in the field of fine arts.
- \$1,000.00 **Dorsey Memorial Music Scholarship.** Applicant must pursue further education and/or training in the field of music.
- \$1,000.00 **Steve & Rebecca Wright Scholarship Honoring Brent Winn.** Applicant must pursue further education and/or training in fine arts.

***Please note that some scholarships may require applicant to provide or submit artistic work. It is important that you review application before submitting as incomplete applications will NOT be considered. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all required information, including supporting documentation is received by the deadline.

Fine Arts Hall of Fame Scholarship - The WHS Ex-Students' Association Fine Arts Hall of Fame Scholarship was established to provide financial support for a graduating senior from Waxahachie Independent School District who is planning to pursue further education and/or training in the fine arts.

Steve & Rebecca Wright Scholarship Honoring Brett Winn – this scholarship was established in 2019 by Stephen Wright & Rebecca Bigham Wright (WHS Class of '73) to honor Brett Winn (WHS Class of '72) to provide financial support for a graduating senior from Waxahachie Independent School District who is planning to pursue further education and/or training in the field of Fine Arts.

➤ **Applicants for the above two scholarships will be required to submit related artistic work:**

- Visual Arts - portfolio containing photos of 3-5 works created in the last three years.
- Music - (band, choir, etc.) a recording of at least 3 minutes in length.
- Theater - (musical, acting, writing, etc.) video / audio performance, at least three minutes in length.
- Culinary - example of prepared food for tasting.
- Literary – writing example.

Dorsey Memorial Music Scholarship - The Dorsey Memorial Music Scholarship was established in 2017 by the family of Harold & Wilma Dorsey to provide financial support for a graduating senior from Waxahachie Independent School District who is planning to pursue further education and/or training in the field of music.

➤ **Applicant will be required to submit:**

- Artistic work in music (band, choir, musical theater, etc.) of a recording totaling a minimum of three minutes in length.

**Fine Arts Hall of Fame Scholarship, Dorsey Memorial Music Scholarship and
Steve & Rebecca Wright Scholarship Honoring Brett Winn**

Eligibility and/or Requirements:

- Applicant must be a graduating student of Waxahachie Independent School District in 2021.
- Applicant must maintain a G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher.
- Applicant must be enrolled in a community college, 4-year college or university, or trade school for the fall semester of 2022.
- The application must include one (1) copy of your official high school transcript.
- The application must include copies of SAT and/or ACT scores.
- Applicant must provide two (2) signed letters of recommendation with one of those being from the teacher in the field of art for which you are applying.
- The applicant must qualify as to leadership, character, dependability, personality, ambition and reputation, as deemed appropriate and proper by the Waxahachie Ex-Students' Association Board of Directors and/or the Scholarship Selection Committee.
- Applicant will be required to submit related artistic work:
 - Visual Arts - portfolio containing photos of 3-5 works created in the last 3 years.
 - Music - (band, choir, etc.) a recording of at least 3 minutes in length.
 - Theater - (musical, acting, writing, etc.) video / audio performance, at least 3 minutes in length.
 - Culinary - example of prepared food for tasting.
 - Literary – writing example.
- Financial need will be considered.
- Signed application and all supporting documents/materials must be submitted to the Waxahachie Ex-Students' Association (P.O. Box 906, Waxahachie 75168) and post marked on or before **March 21, 2022**.
