What Data We Collect

We may collect and process the following types of personal data:

- Identity Data: Name, job title, company name.
- Contact Data: Email address, phone number, postal address.
- **Business Data:** Details about your company and its needs, such as industry and project requirements.
- **Technical Data:** IP address, browser type, and version, time zone settings, and device information.
- Usage Data: Information on how you use our website and services.
- Marketing Data: Preferences for receiving communications and feedback from you.

How We Collect Your Data

We collect data:

Sharing Your Data

- Withdraw consent: Withdraw your consent at any time.
