

Foreword



We recognize the need to pray in and out of season and the need to petition on behalf of others.



JAMES 5:14-16




When the weight of life seems more than you can bear, remember that the grace of God is sufficient for you. It is in those moments that you must remind yourself that His power is made strong in weakness.

Jesus has intentionally chosen to be your friend. When you pray, remember He cares and is concerned about every one of your needs. Never fail to thank Him for being a friend.




PSALM 95:6-7

We pray because the thoughts of our heart bring us into the presence of God.







The time you spend with God is priceless. It brings you into His presence and opens doors of understanding.




Daily Our Father Prayer




Daily Prayer of Salvation




Daily Prayer of Protection & Covering
