Garment Condition & Suitability:I acknowledge that the structural quality, yarn composition, fabric density, and historical treatments (e.g., fabric softeners, water-repellent coatings, starching) of customer-provided garments heavily influence print adhesion, curing parameters, and aesthetic outcome. I certify that I am providing these garments to Right Hand Print as-is for processing.

Assumption of Production Risk:I understand that commercial printing requires extreme heat, precise pneumatic pressure, and specialized chemical curing. While Right Hand Print exercises industry-standard care, I assume all risks of decoration abnormalities, fabric reactions, or processing defects, including but not limited to fabric scorching, heat ring impressions, dye migration, pinholes, fiber tearing, or ink adhesion failure.

Waiver of Reimbursement:Right Hand Print retains no financial liability for replacing, reimbursing, or substituting customer-supplied garments that are damaged, blemished, or rendered unusable during standard industrial decoration processes. Unlike shop-sourced inventory, client-supplied items are decorated purely at the customer's financial risk.

Variability of Adhesion & Vibrancy:I understand that print vibrancy, color correctness, and wash durability may fluctuate significantly on client-supplied textiles compared to blanks natively tested, curated, and sourced directly through Right Hand Print vendors.

Production Spoilage Allowance:In accordance with custom apparel practices, a normal production spoilage margin of 1% to 5% is standard across setup and press runs. I understand it is highly recommended to supply extra placeholder blanks to mitigate shortages in finished fulfillment.
