"My money is growing up... just like me!"



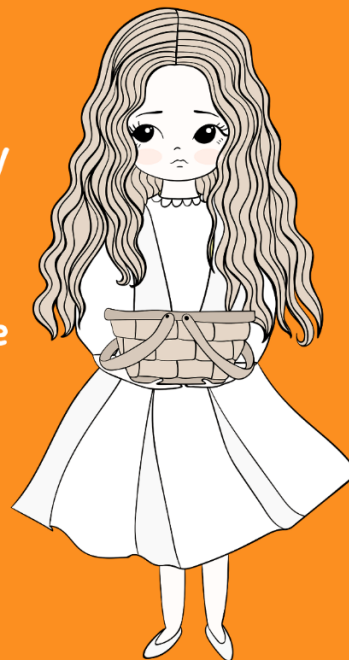
What is Giving?
