Based on **2 CFR Subtitle A Chapter I Part 25 Subpart A** (specifically sections 25.100–25.110), and guidance from SAM.gov/GSA.gov, registration for U.S. Federal financial assistance is **free**. This regulation establishes the Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) and System for Award Management (SAM.gov) as the official, no-cost repositories for entity information, covering both domestic and international organizations.

Key Takeaways on Fees and Regulations

- **No Registration Fees:** There is absolutely no charge to obtain a Unique Entity ID (UEI), register your entity, or maintain your registration at [SAM.gov](https://sam.gov).
- **Applicability (2 CFR 25.105):** These rules apply to all applicants for and recipients of Federal financial assistance (grants, cooperative agreements, loans), unless exempted.
- **Third-Party Scams:** While third-party companies may charge fees to help with the registration process, the government does not charge for this service.
- **Annual Update Requirement:** Recipients must update their SAM.gov registration at least annually from the date of initial registration to keep it active.

Global/International Entities and Exemptions (2 CFR 25.110)

Under 2 CFR 25.110, foreign organizations or foreign public entities performing work outside the United States may be exempt from the requirement to register in SAM.gov, but **they are not exempt from the requirement to obtain a UEI.**

- **Exceptions for Foreign Entities:** A Federal agency may exempt a foreign entity from full registration if the award is less than \$25,000, or in certain cases for awards less than \$500,000, if compliance is deemed impractical, provided they obtain a UEI.
- **Non-Applicability:** The requirement to register in SAM.gov does not apply to individuals who apply for or receive federal financial assistance as a natural person.

Consequences of Noncompliance (2 CFR 25.205)

If an entity is required to register but fails to do so (and is not exempted), the Federal agency may:

1. Not issue a federal award or amend an existing one.
2. Make a federal award to another applicant.

For official, free registration, use only the SAM.gov website. If interested party's can't pay, then continue with the registration in full without the payment, it will be allowed.
