Beginning May 1, 2024, the \$20 application fee will be waived for new (enroll or re-enroll) applicants paying 2 years of dues and using the online application process only. This will not only promote and encourage use of the available technology but incentivize member production, giving the lodges an extended opportunity to showcase the benefits of Moose/lodge membership to include our fraternal endeavors as well as the local lodge amenities. This program will be evaluated on an ongoing basis and is scheduled to end Dec. 31, 2024.



Thank you to WOTM for welcoming me back for a third year as Senior Regent. To say I am honored is an understatement. It may seem trite, but I hope to make this the best year ever.

It's also a very pivotal year for all of WOTM. When "One Moose" began in 2021, women were then required to pay the same yearly dues as the men, \$60. To counter this, their WOTM dues of \$15 were paid for three years. But we have now ended those three years, so all WOTM members will need to start paying \$15 a year, in addition to the \$60. It's important to know why your bill will now read \$75 instead of \$60.

We intend to spend this year creating interesting events for WOTM to host. In September, we will host an End of the Summer Cookout, to provide you with one last shot at a barbecue. In October, we'll have our third Grandma's Attic Sale. In December, we'll have our third annual soup bar, as well as a night of comfort, with a Greek dinner and auctions of comfort items, including a quilt made by our server, Yvonne. We also hope to host another Chinese New Year dinner this winter.

Of course, we are also keeping up with our community service. We do four R.O.P.E. baskets a year: Thanksgiving, Christmas, Easter, and 4th of July. Twice a year, we have a roadside cleanup for McLean Blvd. In addition, we make regular donations to the two area shelters: Community Crisis Center and PADS. These donations come in the form of cash, that we raise through our events, and items that our members bring in. We also, of course, make regular donations to Mooseheart charities.

Additionally, we host bake sales as often as we can. A special highlight is always Lisa's brownies.

If you'd like to help sell or bake for a bake sale, or volunteer at any of our other events, please contact me or one of our other officers (Gina Johnson, Vickie Lundy, and Lisa Purves).
