

Meeting Minutes Franklinton Borough July 1, 2026

Meeting called to order by Council President M. Adams at 7:03 PM

POLICE AND FIRE REPORTS: Police report distributed via email 7/1/2026. Brian Rodgers was present from Wellsville Fire Company after several months' absence and was met with welcome. A discussion was had about a fire call that Wellsville did not respond to in the borough a while back and that the mayor had the fire company across the street respond to "out of friendship."

PUBLIC COMMENT: Chief Wargo and Lt Lohr from Carroll Township police were here to answer questions about e-bikes, No Parking on Church St, and a perpetrator incident that happened in the borough that council wanted to verify the facts on the police response being that they were too busy to respond.

A discussion happened about the No Parking signs. Council asked the solicitor to look for an Ordinance that mentions the No Parking Signs so the Borough can provide that to Carroll Township Police for ticketing in the future.

PARK COMMITTEE- Park Secretary Teresa Adams reminded the Borough Secretary to post the Park Ordinance on the website. A discussion happened about signs for Park Rules and having them revamped possibly. Reported that the York Planning Commission grant application period has opened. The funding may be used to acquire land, to update local plans and ordinances, etc. The Park Committee is looking to have the field leveled so they can get the athletic/softball field completed. P. Brath reminded Teresa Adams that volunteers will be needed in late July or August to put the mulch down and the rest of the

stuff that needs done. M. Adams mentioned the stones that are washing into the newly paved driveway from the upper parking lot to the engineer P. Brath.
