Electronic Recycling information

York County Solid Waste Authority's Residential
Electronics Recycling Program is free and open
to York County residents ONLY.

Material accepted in the programs includes
electronic "covered devices" as well as other
electronic recyclables including cell phones,
vacuum cleaners, alarm clocks, irons and coffee
makers or anything with a plug that does not
contain Freon's. Examples of Freon-containing
items include refrigerators, freezers, air
conditioners and dehumidifiers.

Black Bridge RD, York Electronics Recycling
directions: enter the York County Resource
Recovery Center, located at 2651 Blackbridge
Road, and proceed toward the scales. A worker
will confirm delivery of electronics only and
provide a placard enabling free delivery.
Residents will then follow "Public Drop-off"
signs to the Small Load Drop-off Facility.
Residents will show the electronics placard to the
Small Load Drop-off Facility attendant who will
direct them to the electronics off-load area. Upon
exiting the Small Load Drop-off Facility,
residents will be directed to the designated exit
for the Resource Recovery Center where they will
return the electronics placard and exit the site.
