A NOTICE BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF FRANKLINTOWN BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, OF INTENTION TO ADOPT ORDINANCE RAISING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR PROPERTY TAXATION, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2026.

A public hearing will be held at the regular Borough Council meeting on Wednesday, November 5, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. relative to a proposed ordinance after which same ordinance shall be acted upon by the Borough Council of Franklintown, York County, Pennsylvania. The public hearing will be conducted at the Franklintown Borough Municipal Offices, 116 South Baltimore Street, Franklintown, PA 17323. The proposed ordinance will be available for inspection at the Franklintown Borough Municipal Offices during normal business hours, between 11 A.M. and 1:00 P.M., Mondays through Thursdays, or by calling the Borough Office at 717-432-4047 to schedule an appointment.

The substantial nature of the proposed ordinance is to raise the millage rate for property taxation in the Borough from 2.07 MILLS to 2.87 MILLS, effective January 1, 2026. In the judgment of the Borough Council, the substantial nature of the millage increase to be imposed by the proposed ordinance is to help the Borough in meeting its financial needs in the future, the millage rate having been fixed at 2.07 MILLS since January 1, 2013.
