A NOTICE BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF FRANKLINTOWN BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, OF INTENTION TO ADOPT ORDINANCE REPEALING THE *PER CAPITA* TAX, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2026.

A public hearing will be held at the regular Borough Council meeting on Wednesday, November 5, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. relative to a proposed ordinance, after which same ordinance shall be acted upon by the Borough Council of Franklintown, York County, Pennsylvania. The proposed ordinance will be available for inspection at the Franklintown Borough Municipal Offices during normal business hours, between 11 A.M. and 1:00 P.M., Mondays through Thursdays, or by calling the Borough Office at 717-432-4047 to schedule an appointment.

The substantial nature of the ordinance is to repeal the *per capita* tax which had been enacted on December 3, 1997. In the judgment of the Borough Council, it is in the best interests of the Borough to repeal this tax, as it is no longer necessary or required by the Borough.
