How to Make a Hope Box We are excited to announce that we are collecting Hope Boxes and supplies for our 2025 Mission Trip to the Appalachian Mountains. Our prayer is that we will be able to present a Hope Box and share the love and hope of Jesus Christ with at least 22,000 children at over 60 public schools.

STEP 1: Start with a Sterilite 6 quart plastic shoe box.

STEP 2: Decide if you want to pack for a boy or girl.



STEP 3: Choose an age group

Pre k - 2nd (ages 4 - 8) 3rd - 5th (ages 8 - 11) 6th - 12th (ages 11 - 18)

STEP 4: Fill the plastic shoe box

Fill the plastic shoe box with school supplies, hygiene items, and toys that are appropriate for the age group. We ask that each box contain: A toothbrush, full-size toothpaste, 2 pairs of socks, pencils, 2 or more fun items. The Hope Box should be full, but not stuffed.

Pray for the child receiving the Hope Box as well as the missionary that will be delivering it!


STEP 7: Drop off your Hope Box
