Grannas Paving Projects. Paving has been completed. Penn DOT representative is on vacation so the Board tabled discussion and approving invoices until the July meeting.

2026 Road Projects, Rental Equipment, etc. The Board discussed replacing a box culvert. Ms. Hanscom said the project may be eligible for a Dirt and Gravel grant.

Planning Module for Blarney Stone Development. Mr. MacNamara stated he is abstaining from voting since planning module involves his family business. The module was reviewed by Mr. Taylor and Mr. Bruss. Steve MacNamara discussed the module. Mr. Taylor made a motion to approve the planning module and adopt Resolution 2026-03 for the module. Unionville Borough's request for Traffic Study for speed reduction on SR 220. Mr. Crestani explained the request as it is a free study to be completed by Penn DOT to see if a speed reduction in Unionville Borough is warranted on SR220. Because the approaches to the study area lie within Union Township, Penn DOT is requesting a letter of support for the project. The Board discussed study. The agreed to provide a letter and asked the Secretary to

draft a letter.

OLD BUSINESS

Subdivision Plan for Nancy Tipton and Lot Addition for James Spicer, Jr. Jen Albright, surveyor, was present to discuss the plan and planning module. Mr. Bruss made a motion to approve the plan with no comments to the County and approve the planning module. Mr. MacNamara seconded the motion. Motion carried.
