



be a co-permittee on the DEP Permit, and the Township would have legal access to the dry hydrant. Mr. MacNamara agreed with Mr. Taylor. Mr. MacNamara said that he was up to the hydrant and looked at Borough's water system with Mr. Crestani. Mr. Crestani asked if the Township would be interested in sharing the maintenance of the roadway to the dry hydrant. Mr. Stover said he would not provide any legal advice as he is a solicitor for both municipalities. The Board decided that the Township would maintain the roadway in the summer, but the Borough would be responsible for plowing snow in the winter. It was decided the easement could be 25 ft. and Mr. MacNamara will assist with the easement. Mr. Taylor made a motion that Union Township would be willing to help financially fund the dry hydrant for \$2,075, if, the (1) easement is prepared providing Union Township a 25 ft access easement to the dry hydrant; (2) the Township is listed as a co-permittee on the DEP Permit and provide a copy of the DEP permit for the Township; and (3) Township will split the maintenance of the easement, as the Township would be responsible in the summer, but the Borough would be responsible for snow plowing in the winter. Mr. Bruss seconded the motion. Motion carried.
