

Things Your Pet Needs to Bring When Boarding

DROP OFF is 9:00 a.m.-11:00 a.m. or 1:00 p.m.-4:00 p.m.

PICK UP is 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m.-4:00 p.m.*

*There is a \$15 late charge for pick up after 2 p.m.

<u> Please remember – we are closed for lunch between 12 p.m. and 1 p.m.</u>

- Updated vaccination records.
 - For dogs: rabies & distemper/parvo are required; bordetella is optional.
 - $\circ~$ For cats: rabies and feline distemper are mandatory.
- The pet's bed or a blanket or even a t-shirt that smells like home
- Any special toys we do our best to keep them in their room
- Food marked with how much they are fed at each meal. Sending each meal pre-packaged in baggies is greatly appreciated!
 PLEASE NOTE: We strongly encourage you to bring extra food just in case you're delayed in returning to pick up your fur kid. In the event your pet runs out of food, we will provide a high-quality dry food (Taste of the Wild) and the cost will be added to your pet's stay.
- Dog biscuits, bones, or other special treats
- Any supplements and/or medications in **original containers** marked clearly with dosage, dispensing time and any special instructions (i.e. must be given with food, dispense in pill pocket, etc.)
