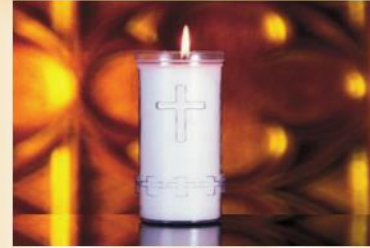

We would not hesitate to say that most, if not all of us are familiar with the song "Amazing Grace," which has been an integral part of Christian worship for years.

While there are many attempts to define "Grace," one definition that often speaks to our hearts is God's "unmerited favor." In other words, we have done nothing to earn it, but the Father extended this Grace to humanity in the person and life of His only Son, Jesus Christ.
