REVISED PROTOCOLS

(Effective May 29, 2021)

- 1. All pews may be used; maintain 3 feet distance between families.
- 2. Masks strongly encouraged but not required for those fully vaccinated.
- 3. Unvaccinated should continue to use mask.
- 4. Holy Communion may be received in the hand or on the tongue.
- 5. Ministers of Holy Communion should wear masks and sanitize hands before and after distributing Holy Communion.
- 6. The temporary suspension of receiving the Precious Blood remains in effect.
- 7. The general dispensation from the Sunday obligation remains in effect for all Catholics.
- 8. Churches and parish buildings should continue to be sanitized at least at end of the day.
- 9. Hand sanitizers should be available at appropriate locations.
- 10. Altar servers are encouraged to return assisting at Masses and wear masks at all services. Music ministers may return also.
- 11. Holy water fonts are to remain empty.
- 12. The faithful should continue to greet each other by a simple bow at the Sign of Peace.
- 13. The protocols previously established for the priest celebrating Mass, for Deacons and for other altar ministers remain in effect.
- 14. Funerals, weddings and visits to the sick and other pastoral activities should take place following the protocols stated here.
- 15. Popular processions may resume following these protocols. e.g Offertory processions.
- 16. Parish events in facilities other than the Church may adjust their activities following these norms.
- 17. Food distribution should be served in individually pre-packaged containers or given out as members of the groups exit the building.
- 18. The permission of the pastor is needed to use parish facilities provided these general norms are observed and the room is sanitized at the end of their gathering.
- 19. Parishes may begin planning their festivals for the fall of 2021 and spring of 2022.
- 20. These protocols are subject to change should conditions change, and new dangers arise.
