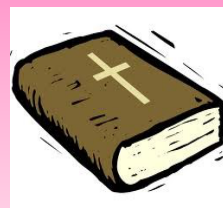

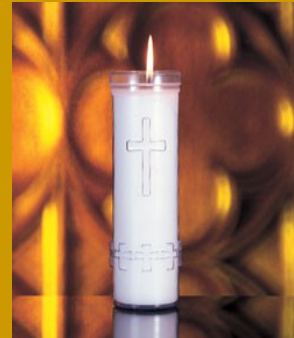

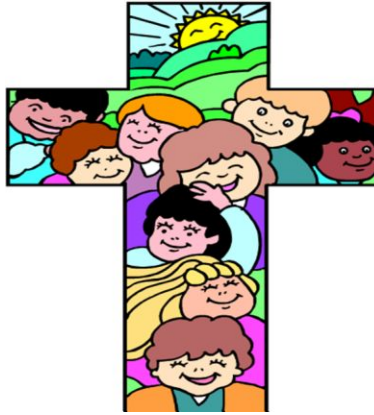

Greetings from the Holy Family CCD office! As Covid-19 cases continue to rise in the Valley, plans are now underway for Holy Family CCD classes for elementary, middle school and 9th grade students to begin **(at home distance learning with parents)** for the well being of all our students and teachers.
