February 5th, 2025 Saint Francis de Sales and the Character of a Christian: Devotion (Part 3 and 4)



February 19th, 2025 Jubilee: 700 Years Seeking Forgiveness

Travel with some of the great experts and cultural leaders of the Church to the four Basilicas in Rome, where pilgrims have visited for centuries. Join the experts as they teach us how each of the four Holy Doors has something to teach us about the Jubilee Year. The documentary focuses especially on the main jubilee of the Church's history, the Great Jubilee of the Year 2000. February 26th, 2025 John of the Cross As a young priest, John of the Cross (1542-1591) is confronted with the corruption of his Carmelite Order, and sets out to live a truly contemplative life. His religious brothers, resenting his holiness and asceticism and his efforts to reform the order, imprison him in a closet for nine torturous months. Undaunted, there he composes much of his immortal poetry, and enters into a mystical union with God. His harrowing escape is miraculous. The saint's moving poem, "The Spiritual Canticle," weaves throughout the film, enriching the story and granting insight into what it means to persevere in love when confronted with suffering. *1 hour*
