# **Questions of the Week ~ Reflect and Respond to the Scripture**

**First Reading:** Isaiah reveals to us God's plan to gather and unite all His people and witness His glory in the age to come. What are you hoping for in the future?

**Second Reading:** The author of Hebrews offers words of encouragement for community members struggling and discouraged in their faith. Is there a friend or co-worker you could look to support this week?

- is Catholic but has not received all the sacraments (Penance, Communion, Confirmation, Matrimony)


If so, we have something for them! All Saints is hosting an Inquiry group on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 pm, beginning on September 17th.


