**Abortion in the U.S.**

- About half of American women have experienced an unintended pregnancy.
- Of these unintended pregnancies, 40% are aborted. [1]
- About 1/3 of American women will have an abortion by age 45. [1]
- 88% of all abortions occur during the first trimester. [1]
- In 2011, Medical, non-surgical abortions (using drugs such as Mifepristone, also known as RU486 or the abortion pill) accounted for 23 % of all abortions, and 36% of abortions before nine weeks' gestation. [1]
- 1.06 million abortions occurred in 2011. From 1973 when abortion was legalized through 2011, more than 53 million abortions have occurred in the U.S. [1]

**Who is having abortions?**

- Age of women in the U.S. who are having abortions: [1]
- 0.4% are under the age of 15
  - 6% are 15-17 years old
  - 11% are 18-19 years old
  - 33% are 20-24 years old
  - 24% are 25-29 years old

**Nationality of women in the U.S. who are having abortions. [1]**

- 30% are black women
- 36% are white women
- 25% are Hispanic women
- 9% are of other nationalities

**Religion of women in the U.S. who are having abortions: [1]**

- 37% identify themselves as Protestant
- 28% identify themselves as Catholic

**Why U.S. women have abortions [1]**

- 75% say they cannot afford to have a child.
- 75% say having a baby would interfere with work, school or other responsibilities.
- 50% say they do not want to be a single parent or are having problems with their husband or partner.

**Adolescents and Sexual/Reproductive Trends [2]**

- Those 15-24 years old in America acquire nearly 1/2 of all new Sexually Transmitted Diseases/Infections, even though they only represent 25% of the sexually active population.
- Nearly half of the 18.9 million new Sexually Transmitted Disease/Infection cases each year are acquired by those 15-24 years old, accounting for 9.1 million new teens with STD/STIs each year.
- In 2010, 26% of pregnancies among those 15-19 years old ended in an abortion.

**California abortions [1]**

- In 2017, 132,680 abortions were provided in California. There was a 16% decline in the abortion rate in California between 2014 and 2017, from 19.5 to 16.4 abortions per 1,000 women of reproductive age. Abortions in California represent 15.4% of all abortions in the United States.
- There were 419 facilities providing abortion in California in 2017, and 161 of those were clinics. These numbers represent a 6% increase in clinics from 2014, when there were 512 abortion-providing facilities overall, of which 152 were clinics.
