OFFICE OF THE VICAR FOR PRIESTS

To assure the safety of all our children and vulnerable people in our diocese, all ministers and volunteers go through a process of background checks and training. This is espe-

cially true of all priests and deacons who minister with us.

No visiting priest or deacon may minister in the Stockton Diocese, even for individual sacraments such as a baptism or a wedding, without first providing a current letter of good standing from his Bishop or Religious Superior.

All deacons and priests who have an assignment in the diocese go through a rigorous and thorough series of background checks, both national and international. For international clergy, a company by the name of Hire Right is contracted to do a thorough background check which includes criminal, educational, and employment history. An investigation is conducted of past ministry and references, as well as the mandatory fingerprinting and safe environment training required of all ministers and volunteers working with our children. In addition, all clergy are required to read and sign a Pastoral Code of Conduct upon accepting an assignment within the Diocese of Stockton. They are also provided with ongoing opportunities for training through an annual retreat and workshops to promote their human and spiritual and ministerial development.

The Office of the Vicar for Priests oversees all these processes of investigation and certification of priests and deacons in our diocese.
