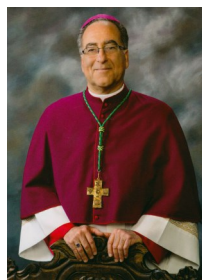




Photo of the Week:

JANUARY 27 – 31, 2020
