PASTOR'S MESSAGE I have an idea to bring young families into the parish, but I need your help. Remember last year I preached and wrote about the local grammar school with a 250-student body? Conservatively, 10% to 15% of them come from homes where at least one parent is Catholic. That translates to 25 to 35

children who should have been in our catechism program. Only one child was participating from this school last year.

I'll be forming a commission of current and retired teachers from primary to high school grades to work with me as a "Think-Tank". With the committee's teaching workexperience within the local, state and federal laws, school administrations and parents, this committee would then brainstorm with me on how to identify and outreach to families who may be searching for a greater union with the Body of Christ. I would then enter into conversations with the parents getting to know them; what matters to them, their concerns, and how I and the church can serve them best. In the process I would invite them to consider praying with the parish community at the Sunday Liturgy.

Throughout the school year, there are several opportunities that I may be present and meet the families at such events as:

- School Board Meetings a)
- b) School Superintendent Meetings
- c) Fundraisers
- d) Sporting Events/Graduations

I think, if I could only be present and make myself available, they may inquire of the Life of the Church. It is potentially a lot of work, but if the school teachers in our parish community can *advise* me on this, it may not be that difficult. This is Outreach and Evangelization of the Faithful, seeking and bringing the Sheep into the Fold. All I need right now is the names of our many schoolteachers in the parish. Will you help me? I invite all our current and former schoolteachers to meet with me. Let me know your names, that we may discuss over dinner at the Rectory House.


ST JOSEPH'S FEAST CELEBRATION MARCH 22ND


