



PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Do you believe Jesus when he said, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me"? (John 14:6) Meaning, the only way to truly obtain life eternal, to come to the "Father who art in heaven", is by means of Christ's life-sacrifice on the cross, his resurrection and ascension into heavenly paradise. By this, Christ won for himself the salvation of the world for those who believe. To be saved is to be rescued from eternal condemnation which is the loss of heaven due to original sin and personal sin. Heaven is the greatest good one could ever hope for. It is to live in the ultimate peace and fullness of joy in God the Father's presence forever.


Look to your earliest life experience at your tender-most age. As a child, when mourning the death of your grandma, grandpa, relative or friend, what did your mother or father say to comfort you? "It's okay sweetheart. They're in Heaven now, a beautiful and wonderful place where there is no more suffering, but happiness with God, who is love. Someday we will get to see and be with him or her again." These words are true for a child's mind and a child's heart, but for a mature person this is half the truth. Heaven is not guaranteed. Did Jesus not say, "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord' will enter the kingdom of heaven..."? (Matt 7:21)

All of Christendom celebrates the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus being raised from the dead on this Easter Sunday. This is the Mother of all Holy Sacrifices, the Holy of Holies we as Catholics celebrate at Mass. Holy Mother Church emphasizes this day because of the miraculous rising of the dead, the Son of God, who is God. If we follow the way, truth, and life of Christ, we too will resurrect with Christ on the last day. This is the basis of our hope for heaven, by our choosing to abide Him, surrendering our will to the will of the Father, obedient to the Moral Law, the Divine Law and the created Natural Law of God. His commandments are conveyed to us through the Sacred Scriptures and the Tradition of Church teachings; the precepts of Divine Revelation that never change. Let Easter be your most Solemn Feast Day and join the mind of the Church that we may be a holy people loving Him and serving Him in one another.


