



PASTOR'S MESSAGE

As we continue into Ordinary Time of the liturgical season of the Church, we can reflect on what we have been hearing in the First Reading regarding the Acts of the Apostles. The fledgling Church grows with the proclamation of the Word of God, the Good News of the Gospel, with the Apostles and the missions of St. Paul. After Pentecost the *Great Evangelization* has taken root and scatters like wildfire from Jewish converts to the Gentiles.

Here at All Saints and St. Joseph's in collaboration with St. Patrick's of Sonora, the Church is about to embark on a great mission in bringing the Good News to the young adults in our communities. A month ago, I hinted of a new ministry aimed at encouraging our young adults in their 20s and 30s; to look again at their Catholic heritage and to accommodate them in their spiritual journeys in their faith and in the sacramental life of the Church. The mission is catholic as it reaches out ecumenically to all who desire to tap into their spiritual origins as creatures of God and sons and daughters of the Father. This evangelization is a proven ministry from the east coast for the past 38 years, called: **"Theology on Tap"**.

The local church is doing outreach, going to where the young adults are; both spiritually and geographically. As God's children and creatures of community, many like to relax among their peers in a social and nonthreatening atmosphere. What better way for the Church to accommodate them where they are at? This would be a venue where the Church talks to them as a group about theology while they are eating pizza, a burger and sipping a coke or a beer, hence the word *"Tap"*. This event would open the conversation regarding their spirituality and the Faith. How is the Faith *relevant* to their everyday lives? There would be scheduled speakers with provocative and informative topics for discussions, combined with a little humor and opportunities for Q & A; similar to Mother Angelica and Saturday Night Live.

There will be two groups that would plan and organize. The Core Team group would be young adult in age and be the "face" of the ministry that plans, organizes and invites the young adult target population. A second team would be the older, *life-experienced* parishioner who would mentor the Younger Core Team. The mentoring team would assist them spiritually with prayer, attend their planning and organizing meetings, help them to stay focused and give sound advice. Mentors would also attend the event. The event would be quarterly our bi-annually.

Our first order of business is to gather the older, *life-experienced* mentoring group together. Would you consider joining this team to help our young adult sons and daughters return to the practice of the Faith? Is God tugging on your heartstrings to help in this *Great Evangelization*? As your pastor, I am asking you to consider how you may contribute in helping our young families take their rightful place in the empty pews. Don't be surprised if I come knocking on your door, or tapping you on the shoulder. Call me or you may tap *me* on the shoulder as to how you can be of help.
