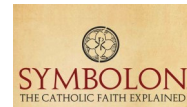

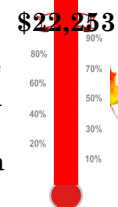

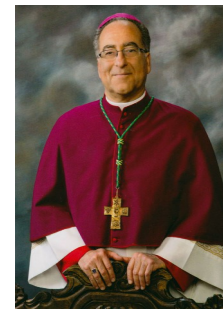

MEMORANDUM: POST ELECTIONS
NOVEMBER 10, 2020

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I thank and commend you for taking the time to faithfully form your conscience and for using that conscience to vote this election year. With so much going on in the world, this election year has been one of the more challenging years that I can remember. I also want to thank my

pastoral staff, clergy, sisters and parish staff throughout the diocese for serving the people in these turbulent and confusing times. They have all worked to put together knowledgeable and informed resources to guide the faithful through this election.

The election has run its course and many laws, propositions, government officials and the President of the United States have been chosen. If the outcome of the election was in favor of your voting preference, I encourage you to do your part in utilizing the outcome to better serve society. If the outcome was not in favor of your voting, then I encourage you to keep advocating for what you think is beneficial for the common good.

The time of year the election takes place is timely because it happens right as we are quickly approaching a season of hope and promise. Advent is weeks away and during this time, we are called to reflect on new beginnings that are only possible through God's grace and mercy.
