
Christmas Boutique Fundraiser



PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Jesus teaches a little parable, based on the Palestinian matrimonial customs, to be prepared at all times of the Lord's return. He is calling us to be prepared for judgment day, when we pass from this life into the next. We never know when that may be, so we must be prudent and live every day as if it were our last. This is the wise thing for us to do. The way to relate to God and men in life is to adhere to the wisdom of the God. Written in the Old Testament 100 B.C. Wisdom is personified as a beautiful woman to be found by those who search for her. The Responsorial Psalm expresses the search for divine Wisdom.

To find Wisdom must first love Wisdom, then she'll appear to us. We must wait patiently with fervent prayer, but we have to watch for her, being ready as in the ten virgins who await the bridegroom.

It is so easy for us to deceive ourselves in what God wants of us. We convince ourselves that God is love and Mercy, yes, but He is first Justice. And to receive mercy, he calls us to repentance and to reform our lives. But if there is no repentance and no changes to amend our lives, then there must be justice. Yes, God is unconditional love as He seeks all men and women to be saved. But God is calling to us to "Listen to His begotten Son in whom He is well pleased." Jesus is teaching us that we must be wise and prudent in knowing that there is a price for discipleship, following him into the Resurrection. That price is surrendering our wills to the will of God; abandoning ourselves to the full teachings of the Father, given to the Son, and then his Church. The unconditional love of the Father is His desire for all men and women to be saved. He sacrifices His Son on the altar of the Cross at Calvary, and the Son who is consubstantial of the Father, sacrifices himself for the love of all humanity... that is his unconditional love, where he expends his whole life, that others may have life in eternity..

To believe that God is unconditional love only, (who will bring us into heaven no matter how disobedient we may be to His Commandments), then we deceive ourselves. How devastating it would be to expect to approach the Gates of Paradise, saying "Master, master! Open the door for me," and be told, "I tell you, I do not know you...be gone, thrown out where there is grinding and gnashing of teeth."

Through Faith and Reason, sensible and wise to what God commands of us, is how we're to enter into the Wedding Feast of Heaven. It is then prudent to abide by the will of God, obedient to His teachings. Let us be watchful always exanimating our consciences as we await the return of the Lord.
