Homily of Easter Vigil

Welcoming Our New Brothers and Sisters in the Risen Lo

This evening we are immersed in a variety of symbols of our faith: fire, the Paschal Candle, Scripture, water, oil, Holy Chrism, bread and wine.

these signs and symbols beg us to acknowledge the Risen Christ in midst. This evening, you, our Catechumens, the Elect, who have preparing to be initiated into the Church, the Church that J established over two thousand years ago, the Catholic Church, welcome and thank God for you. We rejoice in your response to call of Jesus to follow him - to be his disciple.

This evening, you will be baptized into the mystery of the Death Resurrection of Jesus, through the pouring on of water. 
