

Saint Jude Relic:

The most reliable ancient records identify the place of Saint Jude's martyrdom and burial to be the city of Beirut. Sometime later, his body was transferred to Rome and placed in a crypt within the original Saint Peter's Basilica, completed by the Emperor Constantine (in 333 AD). Today, his remains are in the left transept of the current Basilica (completed in 1626), below the main altar of Saint Joseph, within a tomb also holding the remains of the Apostle Simon. This resting place has become a popular destination for pilgrims who have a devotion to the Apostle of the Impossible.

The arm of the saint, which is making its way across North America as part of this tour, was separated from the greater portion of his remains several centuries ago and placed in a simple wooden reliquary carved in the shape of an upright arm in the gesture of imparting a blessing.

The reliquary was last opened during the time of Cardinal Francesco Marchetti Selvaggiani, who served as Vicar General of His Holiness (Vicar General for the Archdiocese of Rome) from 1931-1951. His seals enclose it, ensuring provenance and authenticity. (www.ApostleOfTheImpossible.com)

The world is filled with people whose basic needs aren't n whether for clean water, nutrition, safety, education, meaning ful work, stable family life, basic medical resources, religio freedom, and the right to life. So how can we possibly belie what Psalm 145 says to us this week, "The hand of the Lo feeds us, he answers all our needs"? Does he? What ab the countless poor? Can't we identify at least a few unr needs in our own lives right now? Is the Bible promoting with ful thinking and laziness in helping others?

No. The psalm flows from Israel's experience of God's rele less fidelity again and again -especially in the Passover fr Egypt. This divine providence is recalled when Jesus feeds needy multitudes in the Gospel of John. Passover arrives or again, and the people are hungry like the ancient Israelites the wilderness journey. What is new is that in Jesus God only provides for their needs, but He learns what it's like have those human needs. He shares them too. He feeds the bread and fish; and even more, He hungers to provide the and us, much more than just that kind of perishable food.

Our deepest need is for God. Like the multiplied bread, earthly provisions ultimately fail, for we all finally die. course, our obligation to meet the needs of the poor is bas But Christ promises to feed us with the one bread that ne fails: God Himself. He is humanity's eternal food. If we eat bread, we taste the faithfulness of God who answers all needs, even when every earthly thing fails.
